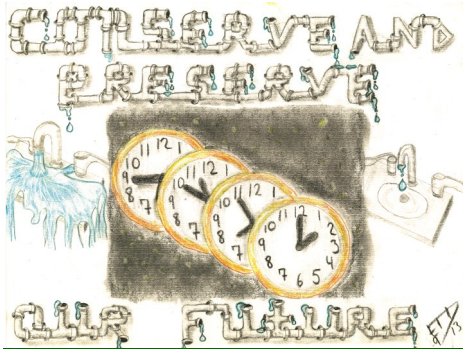
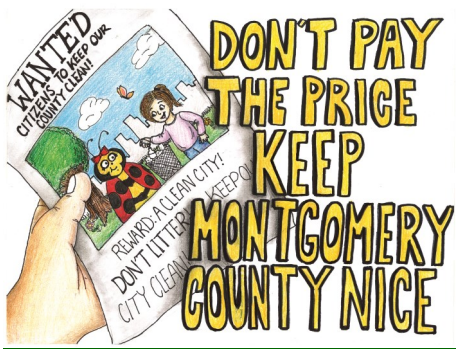

Environmental Calendar Contest Guidelines

Montgomery County Environmental Services sponsors the Environmental Calendar Contest. The contest is open to all Montgomery County K-12 students. Students are asked to create an original piece of art that creatively expresses our need to preserve water or our need to Reduce, Reuse and Recycle to conserve resources.

Contest Guidelines:

- The contest is open to Montgomery County students in grades K-12.
- One entry per student may be submitted.
- Entries must be one dimensional, flat, horizontal layout.
- Entry form must be taped to the back of the artwork.
- Entries must be postmarked by September 29, 2017.
- Winners will be notified by October 20, 2017.

Judging Guidelines:

- Entries will be judged against all other entries in the same division.

Contest Eligibility and Guidelines

- Open to all Montgomery County students, grades 2-12.
- Please note if a student is entering under Special Education division.
- One entry per person, one author per entry.
- Poetry theme must relate to the environment.
- Entries must be legible.
- Please submit using 8½ x 11 white paper, or submit online.
- No artwork on entries.

On the back of poetry entry, please include:

- Student's name
- Complete address, including city and zip code
- School name, grade and teacher's name
- Teacher's phone number or e-mail address

Entries will be judged on theme usage, creativity, style, punctuation, spelling, and neatness. Late entries and entries not following contest guidelines will be disqualified.
