Division of Criminal Justice Services

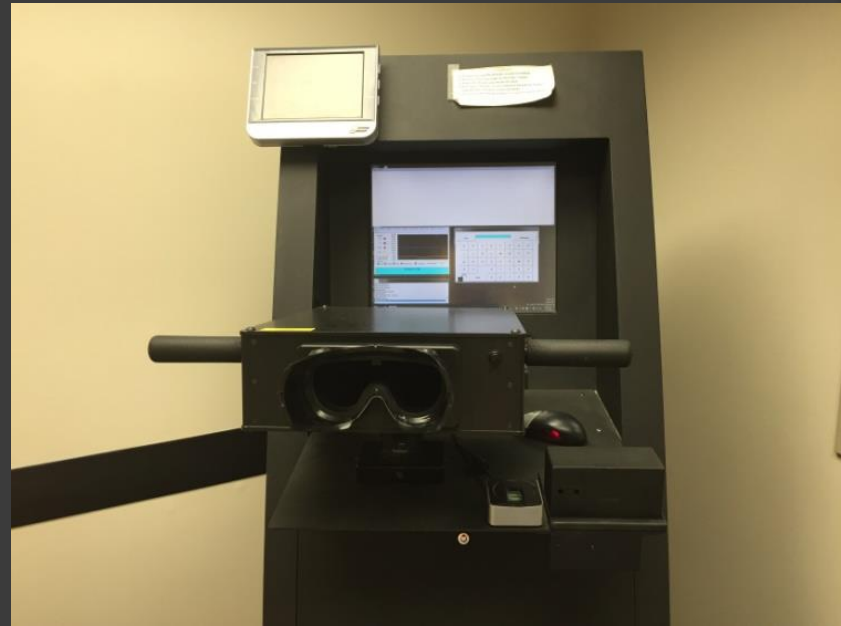
- Provides supervision and investigative services for felony and misdemeanor cases.
- Provides meaningful intervention with offenders by addressing major areas of risk/need.
- Provides timely communication to the Court.

Specialized Dockets

- **Drug Court** (1996)--Offenders on Intervention in Lieu of Conviction for low level felonies.
- **Veteran's Treatment Court** (2013)—ensures specialized intervention for Veterans.
- **Women's Therapeutic Court** (2014)—gender specific intervention for female offenders.
- **Ohio Mental Health and Addiction Services (OMHAS) funded three positions for these specialty dockets.**

Specialized Services, cont.

- Ocular/
Urinalysis Drug Testing



- Intensive Supervision Program (1984)--specialize in Judicial Release (Funded by Community Corrections Act (CCA) grant through ODRC).
- Chemical Offender Program (1990)--Community drug/alcohol intervention/education (Funded by Community Corrections Act (CCA) grant through ODRC).

Specialized Services, continued

- Victims of Violence Impact Panels
- DUI Impact Panels
- Drug Impact Panels
- Referrals to the MonDay (CBCF)—a program funded by ODRC

Grants

- Ohio Mental Health and Addiction Services (OMHAS): provided funding for three subsidy positions to assist with Specialty Court Dockets.
- Addiction Treatment Program (ATP)—OMHAS provided 169 slots at \$2,000 per slot for Medically Assisted Treatment (MAT) for Specialty Court clients. Funds are to be provided to the treatment provider and monitored by the Probation Department.
- Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Association (SAMHSA)—provided funding to the Probation Department for MAT for probationers through Cornerstone-Project with a research component by Wright State University.
- Community Corrections Act (CCA) through ODRC—provides funding for 14 positions in the Probation Department for the maintenance and operation of an intensive supervision to divert offenders from prison.

Secure Transitional Offender Program (STOP)

- Transitional--Assists offenders in adjusting to a drug-free life style
- Houses 96 (48 male/48 female) offenders who have been sanctioned to local jail time (felons/misdemeanants).
- **Male beds funded by the General Division**
- **Female beds funded by Probation Improvement Incentive Grant (PIIG) from ODRC.**

STOP



- STOP partners with ODRC
- STOP, 96 beds: 48 men/48 women
 - STOP women's facility accepts referrals from area Municipal Courts:
Kettering, Vandalia, Miamisburg,
Montgomery County East and West
 - Success Rate 95%

Day Reporting Program

- Partnering with ODRC
- Collaboration with community social service agencies and treatment providers
- Offenders sanctioned to Day Reporting instead of jail or prison
- Offenders ordered to Day Reporting from STOP, MonDay, VOA, APA, Re-entry or Gateway
- Projected to open in the Fall 2016
