Charges Approved in Harrison Township Homicide
State v. Charlie W. Myers
2009-CR-46

Montgomery County Prosecuting Attorney Mathias H. Heck, Jr. announced that charges will be filed today against 22 year old Charlie William Myers in connection with the shooting death of 29 year old Jenny Nelson in her Harrison Township home on January 2, 2009. The defendant was arrested in Franklin County, Ohio on January 4, 2009.

A panel of Assistant Prosecutors assigned to the Violent Crimes Bureau of the Prosecutor's Office met with investigators of Montgomery County Sheriff Phil Plummer and reviewed the facts in the case.

Myers has been charged with:

- Eight counts Aggravated Murder
- Two counts Aggravated Robbery
- Two counts Aggravated Burglary
- Four counts Kidnapping
- One count Gross Sexual Imposition
- One count Grand Theft – Motor Vehicle
- One count Receiving Stolen Property – Motor Vehicle
- One count Having Weapons While Under Disability

All charges include mandatory three year firearm specifications.

A panel of the most experienced prosecutors will convene in the near future to discuss whether death penalty specifications should be added for the Montgomery County Grand Jury's consideration.
