The Montgomery County Grand Jury has indicted 55 year old **Gloria J. Murphy** on two felony counts for having sexual conduct with a 12 year old boy. During the late evening hours of January 29 into the early morning hours of January 30, 2009 the victim was at the home of the defendant on Rawlings Drive, Dayton. The defendant provided alcohol to the victim, after which she had sexual conduct with the minor.

The defendant is indicted on:

- One count of Rape – victim under 13
- One count of Gross Sexual Imposition – victim under 13

Rape of a victim under 13 years of age is a first degree felony and carries a possible sentence of 10 years to life. Gross Sexual Imposition of a victim under 13 years of age is a third degree felony, punishable by up to 5 years incarceration.

Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck said, "This defendant took advantage of a neighborhood child by providing him alcohol and having sex with him. It is simply unacceptable for anyone to abuse and victimize the children of our community."
