Montgomery County Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced that the Montgomery County Grand Jury has indicted 52 year old **Anthony Wayne Jones** and 29 year old **Demetrius Ewing** on multiple felony and misdemeanor counts as a result of their committing a robbery at 5483 Misty Lane in Huber Heights on February 22, 2009.

The defendants entered the apartment on Misty Lane with the intention of robbing the tenant. During the robbery, the tenant was shot, and three others were assaulted and robbed of their property.

The Grand Jury indicted defendant Jones on the following charges:

- Two counts Aggravated Burglary
- Four counts Kidnapping
- Five counts Aggravated Robbery
- Two counts Felonious Assault
- Three counts Assault
- One count Having Weapons While Under Disability
- One count Tampering With Evidence

Defendant Ewing was indicted on the following charges:

- Two counts Aggravated Burglary
- Four counts Kidnapping
- Five counts Aggravated Robbery
- Two counts Felonious Assault
- Three counts Assault
- One count Having Weapons While Under Disability

All of the aggravated robbery, kidnapping, aggravated burglary and felonious assault charges include three year firearm specifications. Repeat violent offender specifications are included in the charges against defendant Ewing. Both defendants face a possible sentence in excess of 80 years in the penitentiary.
