State v. James A. Simpson
2008-CR-2913

The Montgomery County Grand Jury indicted 36 year old James A. Simpson for the beating death of 42 year old Allison Beaty on July 16, 2008.

Simpson was indicted for five counts:

- Murder
- Felonious Assault
- Tampering with Evidence
- Grand Theft Motor Vehicle
- Domestic Violence

The victim's body was discovered in the home they shared with four children on Allwen Drive in Dayton. The defendant beat Beaty to death following an argument.

Mat Heck, Jr. said, "This was a tragic and senseless death that leaves four children without their mother. We must not allow violence like this to destroy our community."
