Montgomery County Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. sponsors a biannual, two-day law enforcement conference. This year the conference will be held September 14 and 15, 2009, at Sinclair Community College. The conference is open to all prosecutors, both municipal and County, as well as any law enforcement officer.

This year's agenda includes topics of interest to all law enforcement personnel, including updates on the fourth amendment, effective communication skills, ethics, public records laws, etc. A special guest speaker, Jerry M. Blair, will discuss his prosecution of serial killer Ted Bundy in 1980. Mr. Blair is a retired State Attorney for the Third Judicial Circuit in Florida.
