## PRESS STATEMENT

October 18, 2010

### Rapist of 15-Year-Old Indicted State v. Billy Balidbid 2010-CR-3244

Today, the Grand Jury voted to indict 26-year-old **Billy Balidbid**, for the September 17, 2010 Rape and Kidnapping of a 15 year old child.

The defendant was indicted on:

- One count of Rape by Force or Threat of Force
- One count of Kidnapping for Sexual Activity

Both charges are 1<sup>st</sup> degree felony counts and carry a maximum penalty of 10 years incarceration each.

This 15 year old victim was walking home from school on Boltin Street in Dayton, when she was grabbed off of the street and carried to an abandoned house. Inside that house, the defendant repeatedly raped her. After the victim was able to struggle free, she ran out of the house and hid behind a car until she was able to summon help from a neighbor.

The police with the assistance of the victim developed a composite sketch of the suspect, which was released to the public on September 22, 2010. Many tips came into the crime stoppers hotline, including several from prostitutes who had also been beaten and abused by the defendant. A detailed description of the defendant was provided to the police, including the type of car he drove and the area in which he frequented.

The defendant was arrested on October 8, 2010. He is currently in the Montgomery County Jail, being held on a \$1,000,000 bond. He will be arraigned on October 21, 2010 at 8:30 a.m.

Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. said, "It is sad that this 15-year-old child was abducted on her way home from school and violently, repeatedly raped by this defendant. This case illustrates the importance of contacting the police when you have information about a crime."

**SECOND COUNT:**

AND the grand jurors of this County, in the name and by the authority of the State of Ohio, upon their oaths, do find and present that: **BILLY BALIDBID** on or about **SEPTEMBER 17, 2010** in the County of Montgomery, aforesaid, and State of Ohio, did by force, threat or deception, or in the case of a victim under the age of thirteen or mentally incompetent, by any means, did remove another from the place where the other person was found or restrain the liberty of the other person, for the purpose of engaging in sexual activity, as defined in Section 2907.01 of the Revised Code, with the victim against the victim's will; in violation of Section 2905.01(A)(4) of the Ohio Revised Code) in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.
