

## **MIKE FAIN**

Judge Fain was first elected to the Second District Court of Appeals in 1986. Judge Fain received his B.A. from Yale College in 1968, and his J.D. from the University of Pennsylvania Law School in 1972, with American Jurisprudence awards in Constitutional Law and in International Law. Judge Fain was born in Miami, Florida, in 1946, and has resided in several states while obtaining his education and during his service in the United States Navy Reserve. Judge Fain entered the general practice of law in Dayton in 1973. He lives in Washington Township, in Montgomery County, with his wife, Hui, and his daughter, Sophia, born in 2008. He has two grown sons.

Judge Fain's other interests have placed him in leadership positions on many community committees and boards. He has been a lecturer on law and legal-related topics, and has served as an adjunct professor at the University of Dayton Law School. Judge Fain is an active member of the Ohio Courts of Appeals Judges Association, serving as its Chief Justice in 2005. He was Chair of the Criminal Law and Procedure Committee of the Ohio Judicial Conference, and served on the Supreme Court's Rules Advisory Committee, including one year as Chair. Judge Fain currently serves on the Appellate Practice Committees of the Dayton and Ohio State Bar Associations. He also enjoys serving regularly as a judge of the high school mock trial program at both the state and national levels, and has served as judge of the high school "We the People" competition on the Constitution and the Bill of Rights at both the state and national levels.
