Retail Health Clinics can help you make time for your health

As you drive home from work, you think about the errands you need to take care of – go to the bank, buy groceries and make dinner. Then you remember that sore throat that's been bothering you for several days and you know it's time for you to get checked out.

While seeing your primary doctor is usually your first choice, now there's another option – Retail Health Clinics.

Health care services right where you shop

You don't need to make an appointment since most Retail Health Clinics are located in retail settings, such as a pharmacy or large store. They are generally open during the same days and hours as the store (including weekend and evenings).

In addition to offering care for common illnesses, Retail Health Clinics also provide wellness and prevention services, such as camp physicals and cholesterol and diabetes screenings.

Retail Health Clinics are staffed by physician assistants and/or nurse practitioners who are supervised by an offsite doctor who is available by phone for consultation. If needed, you will be referred to local doctors or hospitals for care.

You can visit a Retail Health Clinic for these types of conditions

- Allergic reactions/hives
- Back pain
- Cough or colds
- Fevers
- Diarrhea
- Ear or sinus pain
- Headaches
- Nausea, vomiting
- Eye swelling/irritation
- Rashes and minor burns
- Small fractures, sprains and strains
- Stitches
- Sore throat
- Burning with urination or discharge
- Treatment for conditions may vary by location. Contact the Retail Health Clinic near you for a full listing of conditions.

Retail Health Clinics also provide vaccinations for

- DTaP (diphtheria, tetanus and pertussis)
- Hepatitis A and B
- Influenza
- Meningitis
- MMR (measles, mumps and rubella)
- Pneumonia
- Polio
- Td (tetanus and diphtheria)
