Tennessee Man Guilty of Shooting at Police and Responsible for Death of Girlfriend

State v. Conrad Davis, 2016-CR-3425

DAYTON, OH (1/6/2017) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **CONRAD E. DAVIS**, 27, of Cookeville, Tennessee was found guilty on counts related to the October 31, 2016 shootings that left a Brookville Police Officer injured and the defendant's girlfriend dead.

Today, the defendant pled guilty by a Bill of Information to:

- One count of Involuntary Manslaughter, a 1st-degree felony
- One count of Felonious Assault on a Peace Officer, causing serious physical harm, a 1st-degree felony
- One count of Felonious Assault on a Peace Officer, using a deadly weapon, a 1st-degree felony

Additionally, the defendant pled guilty to three gun specifications:

- A 3-year specification for using a firearm
- A 5-year specification for shooting from a motor vehicle
- A 7-year specification for shooting at a police officer

He will be sentenced on February 10, 2017 at 4:00 p.m.
