18 Year-Old Indicted for Murder of 14 Year-Old

State v. Jason Tidwell, 2017-CR-2101/2

DAYTON, OH (07/13/2017) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **JASON DOUGLAS TIDWELL**, 18, of Dayton, has been indicted for causing the shooting death of 14-year-old Mackenna Kronenberger on July 5, 2017.

On Wednesday, July 5, 2017, the victim was inside her Morse Avenue home when she was struck and killed by a gunshot from outside. The investigation determined that the defendant had been in a fight with another 18-year-old, Dylan M. Angel. Gunshots were fired, and one of the shots entered the home of the victim and killed the defendant's stepsister. Both Angel and Tidwell were taken into custody.

Today, the Montgomery County Grand Jury indicted the defendant on:

- One count of Murder
- One count of Felonious Assault with a deadly weapon
- One count of Discharge of a Firearm On or Near Prohibited Premises
- One count of Tampering With Evidence
- One count of Having Weapons While Under Disability

The defendant is currently in custody in the Montgomery County Jail, being held on a \$1,000,000 bond. He will be arraigned on July 18, 2017, at 8:30 a.m.

The Montgomery County Grand Jury declined to indict Dylan Angel on any felony charges due to insufficient evidence. Therefore, he will be released from custody.

The investigation is ongoing.
