**Cincinnati Man Indicted in Plush Gentlemen's Club Shooting**

*State v. Demetrius Williams, 2017-CR-2793*

**DAYTON, OH (9/15/2017)** – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **DEMETRIUS WILLIAMS**, 40, of Cincinnati, has been indicted on counts related to a double shooting in Harrison Township.

During the early morning hours of September 4, 2017, the defendant and a number of friends traveled from Cincinnati to Dayton to go clubbing. Eventually, the group arrived in three vehicles at Plush Gentlemen's Club in Harrison Township. The defendant arrived in a separate vehicle than the victims arrived in. After all the men exited their vehicles, the defendant pulled out a handgun and fatally shot 20-year-old Pierre Jackson, as well as fired multiple shots at the other victim as he was running away. The second victim was struck by bullets multiple times.

A security guard from the club heard the gunshots and ran towards the defendant, tackled him, and took the defendant to the ground. He then held the defendant until deputies arrived.

Today, the defendant was indicted on:

- Two counts of Murder
- Four counts Felonious Assault
- One count of Having Weapons Under Disability from a prior drug offense.

The counts of murder and felonious assault include mandatory three-year firearm specifications.

The defendant is currently in custody at the Montgomery County Jail, being held on a \$1,000,000 bond. He will be arraigned on Tuesday, September 19, 2017, at 8:30 a.m.
