

1 Start: Insert Card

Insert voter access card into slot at upper right side of the screen.

Card should be face up with arrow pointing left.

Push card firmly in until it clicks.

2 Read "Instructions" Screen

Before you begin the voting process, you can magnify or change the contrast of your ballot to help increase readability.

To begin voting, **touch** the "Next" button on the screen. You will use the "Next" button to see each ballot page until you have reached the end of the ballot.

3 Select Candidates or Issues OR Select "Write-In" if Desired

Touch the box on the screen next to your choice. An "X" will appear designating your selection.

To change or cancel your selection, **touch** the box again and make another selection.

If there are write-in candidates on the ballot you would like to vote for, select "write-in" and a keyboard will appear on the screen.

Type the write-in you would like, then select "Record Write-In."

The normal voting screen will return and the name you entered will appear as the choice for that particular race.

Touch "Back" to review previous pages.

4 Review Your Ballot

On the Summary Page, review your choices.

Items in red are races that were left blank or incomplete.

If you want to vote for a race that was left blank, incomplete, or change your vote for any race, just **touch** the desired race you would like to change and you will be taken back to the proper page to cast your vote.

5 Print Ballot for Verification

To verify your selections, **touch** "Print Ballot" and you will see an enclosed printed copy of your choices to the right of your machine.

After reviewing your ballot printout you can either cast or reject your ballot.

6 Cast Your Ballot

Touch "Cast Ballot" when you are ready to record your vote. Once your ballot has been cast, the printer will scroll to hide your selections.

7 Finish: Remove Card

You have completed the electronic touch screen voting process.

Remove your voter access card and return it to a poll worker.



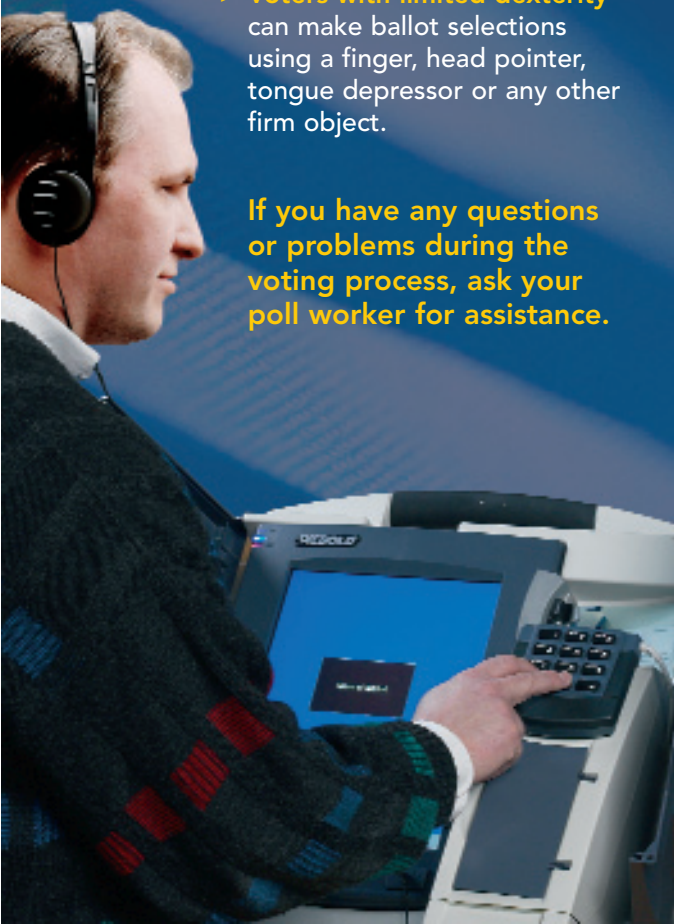

For voters requiring special assistance

- > **Blind voters** can navigate through the entire ballot without assistance, in complete privacy, using voice guidance prompts.
- > **Voters with limited vision** can use the magnification feature, enabling them to vote unassisted in a clear, comfortable manner, and in complete privacy. A magnifying lens also helps to verify the printed ballot.
- > **Voters in wheelchairs** have full accessibility to the Diebold Touch Screen voting station.

> **Voters with limited dexterity** can make ballot selections using a finger, head pointer, tongue depressor or any other firm object.

If you have any questions or problems during the voting process, ask your poll worker for assistance.
