Dear Ms. Lieberman:

At the October 12, 2011 meeting, the Automatic Data Processing Board unanimously approved the acceptance of the proposal from **Future Technologies, Inc.**, the only bid received, for the purchase of paternity software for the **Crime Laboratory**. They submitted a bid for the software at a cost of **\$48,000.00**. This purchase would be funded through a grant from the National Institute of Justice.

Next, the ADP Board approved unanimously the request from the **Board of Developmental Disabilities Services** to purchase an upgrade to their EMC storage network. This upgrade would be purchased from **Advizex Technologies** at a cost of **\$77,907.00**. Funding would come from their capital fund as part of the "5 Year Capital Plan".

The Board also unanimously approved a request from the **Common Pleas Court, General Division** to purchase 47 HP Desktop computers (\$22,278.00), 47 Philips Monitors (\$5,593.00) and 47 copies of Symantec Ghost Software (\$1,621.492) for a total cost of **\$29,492.00**. The purchases would be made from **CDW-G** off the Ohio State Term Schedule Contract (533114-1-7). Funding would come from the Reibold Project - Court Funded (OCA code 439500).

Lastly, the ADP Board voted unanimously to approve the request from the **Treasurer's Office** for the replacement purchase of 40 Dell workstation PCs, 41 monitors and 30 HP LaserJet printers. The purchase would be made from **MNJ Technologies** at a cost of approximately \$71,460.58. This purchase would be paid for out of existing Treasurer's Office Incentive to Save funds.
