Our Community

- The JFS staff showed a rapid response to individuals in need in our community.
- One in 50 residents receive JFS assistance.
- One in 9 residents receive food stamps.
- On average, there has been a 1 to 2% increase in food stamp applications in 2009.
- There has been a 17% increase in food stamp applications from this time last year

Food Drive Activities

- **All JFS Casual Day** – Cost: \$3.00 or 3 canned goods. Collection: \$246.00
- **Raffle Proceeds** – Raised \$1,366.50
- **Food/Candy Cart at Reibold** – Candies, treats and healthy snacks were sold at the Reibold Building for a collection of \$93.50
- **Miscellaneous Cash Donations** - \$414.00
- **Donated sales of Entertainment Books:** \$580.00
