



Homeless Point-in-Time Count 2009

Dayton & Montgomery County



PIT Process

- Community volunteers surveyed guests at St. Vincent Hotel to collect subpopulation information

- Outreach teams working with Dayton Police and Montgomery County Sheriff's Department conducted early morning street count
- Sheltered numbers generated by HMIS



January 29, 2009

- 861 homeless adults and children in shelters, transitional housing, or unsheltered
- 110 families with 218 children
- 526 unaccompanied singles
- 14 unsheltered single adults

PIT Comparison 2008 - 2009

Homeless Population	2008	2009	% Change
Families	119	110	-8%
Persons in Families	360	335	-7%
Unaccompanied Singles	484	526	+9%
Total	844	861	+2%



Changes Impacting Numbers

- Reduced capacity at Red Cross family shelter in 2009
-
- Increased capacity in transitional housing inventory
 - Winter storm with 6-8 inches of snow and ice on ground

Chronic Homelessness

- 52 individuals identified as “chronic” during 2009 PIT count

2007	2008	2009
120	72	52

- More than 50% decrease in number of chronically homeless individuals
 - Increase in permanent supportive housing units
 - Increased assessment and targeting by shelter case managers
