Vaccines

- Weekly vaccine shipments October - January
- 340 providers registered in Montgomery Co.
- Vaccine allocation by ODH
- Children 6 months to 9 years – two doses
- Individuals \geq age 10 – one dose
- Priority Groups
 - pregnant women
 - household contacts of children < 6 months of age
 - health care and emergency medical services (EMS) workers
 - individuals aged 6 months through 24 years
 - individuals 25 - 64 years of age who have medical conditions



Anti-virals

- ODH stockpile delivered to hospitals and local health departments
 - Tamiflu and Relenza
 - used for treatment only
- PHDMC to resupply hospitals, FQHC, and any local pharmacies (non-national chains)



PHDMC Vaccination Clinics

- Schools K-12
 - 40 districts/schools
 - 83,000 students in 173 buildings
 - scheduled October 27 through November
- Points of Dispensing (POD)
 - general population priority groups
 - initially 1 POD per week on Thursdays from 11 AM to 7 PM
 - October 29, November 5, November 12
