### **Montgomery County Treasurer Begins Delinquent Collections**

Dayton, Ohio – Montgomery County Treasurer Carolyn Rice announced the beginning of her Office’s delinquent tax collection period for calendar year 2009. All property owners with delinquent taxes (including unpaid balances for 1<sup>st</sup> half 2008, payable 2009) are potentially eligible to sign up for a payment plan to repay their delinquent taxes. Formal payment plans are available for those taxpayers that qualify and must include a down payment when the payment plan is created.

Delinquent properties with active plans will not accrue additional interest and/or penalty. Additionally, properties with active plans will be excluded from tax foreclosure and tax lien certificate sales.

Current—or new—real estates taxes **MUST** be paid on properties under a delinquent payment plan. Failure to pay current—or new—real estate taxes will void the payment plan and the assessment of previously waived penalties and interest.
