Treasurer's Office Open on Saturday, July 11; Taxes due July 15

Dayton, Ohio – Montgomery County Treasurer Carolyn Rice announced that her office will be open on Saturday, July 11, to provide taxpayers a convenient opportunity to visit the Treasurer's office outside of normal business hours. The office, located on the Second Floor of the Montgomery County Administration Building at 451 W. Third Street in Dayton, will be open between 8:00 a.m. – 12 noon on July 11.

Taxpayers can pay their tax bills with cash, check or Discover credit card at the Treasurer's Office. The Treasurer's website, www.mctreas.org/treasurer, provides links to pay by electronic check or by American Express, Master Card or Visa through services offered by Official Payments. Official Payments also accepts credit card payment by phone: call 1-800-2PAY TAX, enter jurisdiction code 4530 and follow the voice prompts. **American Express, MasterCard and Visa are NOT accepted in the Treasurer's office – ONLY online or by telephone through Official Payments. All credit card payments are subject to a convenience fee.**

A payment sent by mail is considered paid on time as long as it is **postmarked** (not metered) **on or before the due date of July 15**. Online payments are considered paid on time if the payment process is completed by 11:59 PM on the due date.

A 5% penalty will be applied to all Second Half 2008 tax charges that are paid on or between July 16, 2009 and July 26, 2009. A 10% penalty is applied to all Second Half 2008 tax charges that have not been paid as of July 27, 2009.

Regular business hours for the Treasurer's office are 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Taxpayers are welcome to contact the Treasurer's office at (937) 225-4010 – Option 1 for Taxpayer Services, Option 2 for Delinquency, Option 4 for Prepayment, Option 6 for Personal Property – or visit the Treasurer's webpages online at www.mcoho.org/treasurer.
