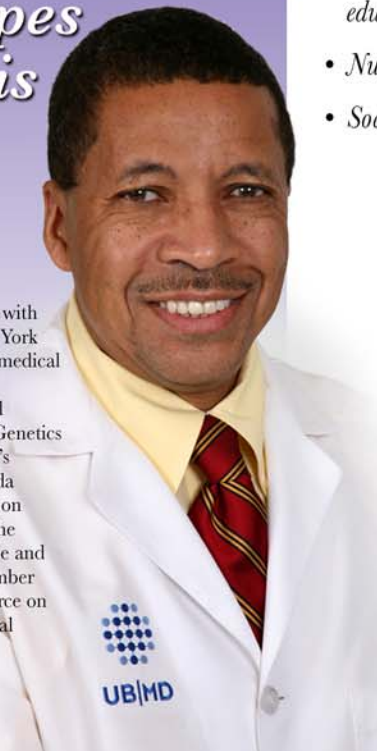

Luther K. Robinson, MD, is with the State University of New York School of Medicine and Biomedical Sciences, and is Director of Dysmorphology and Clinical Genetics in the Division of Genetics of the Women and Children's Hospital of Buffalo at Kaleida Health. He conducts studies on Fetal Alcohol Syndrome in the United States, Russia, Europe and South Africa, and was a member of the first National Task Force on Fetal Alcohol Syndrome/Fetal Alcohol Effects.
