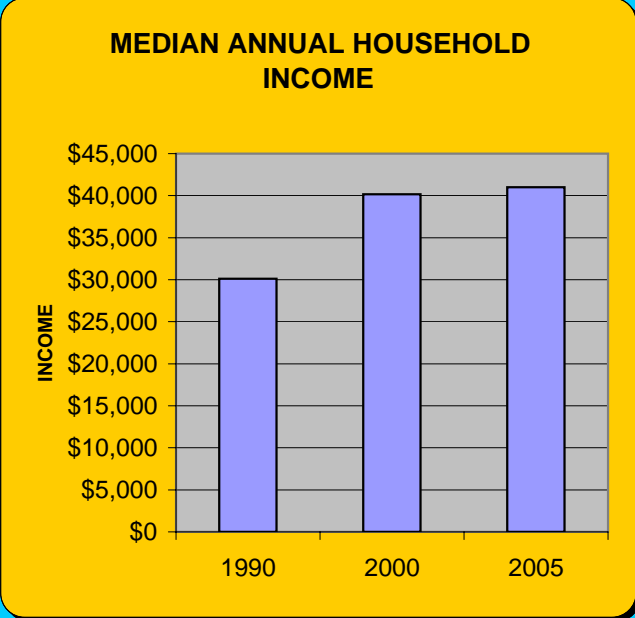
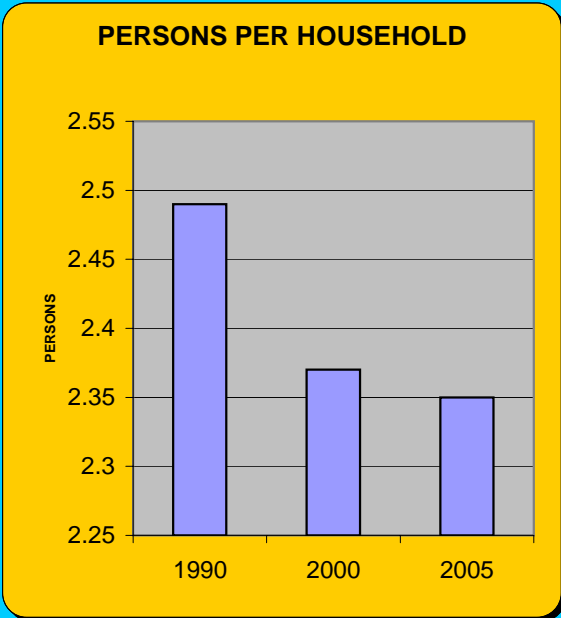
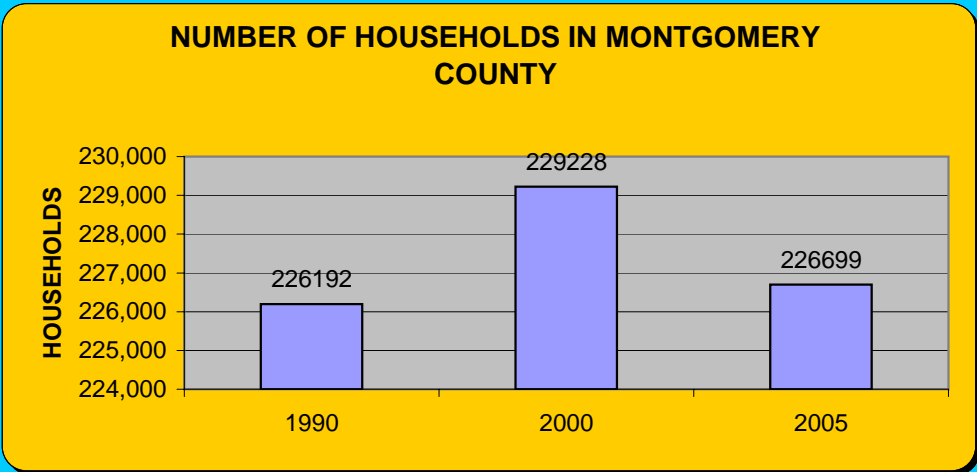
GENERAL POPULATION DATA FROM U S CENSUS FOR MONTGOMERY COUNTY

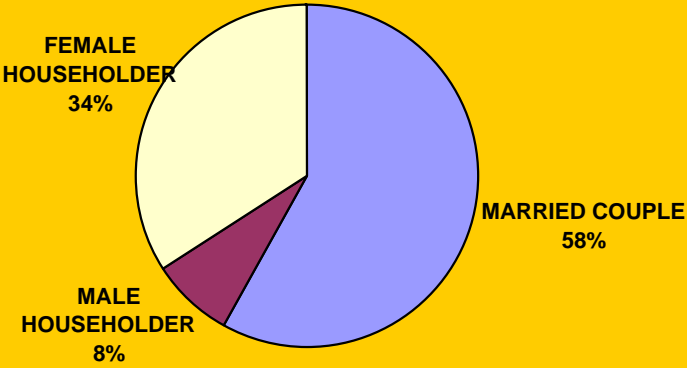

SIZE OF HOUSEHOLDS IN THE COUNTY: 2005



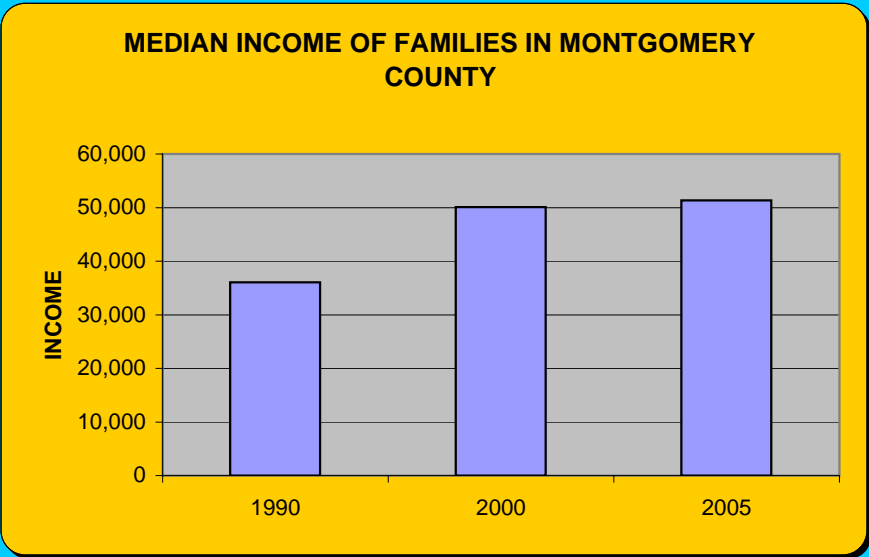
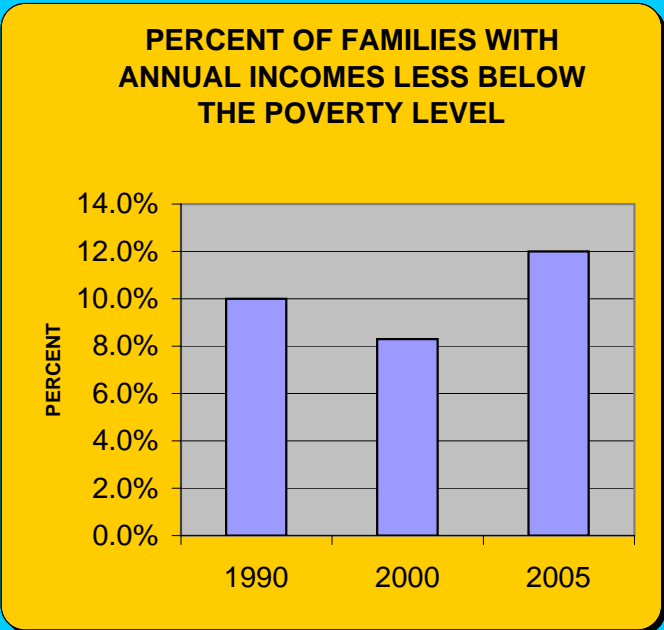
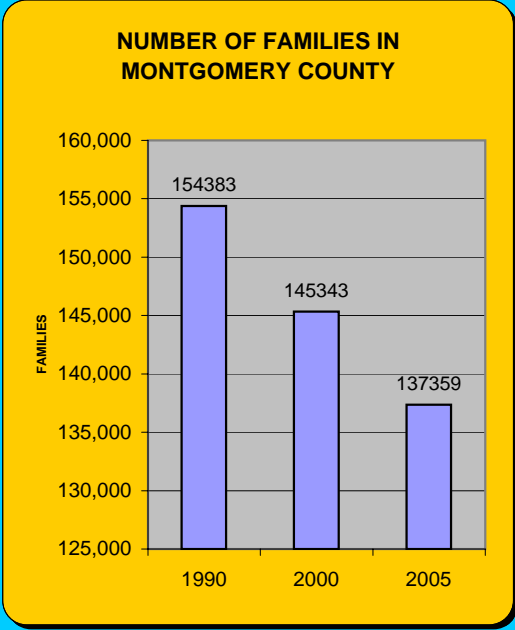
**FAMILIES WITH OWN CHILDREN UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE AT HOME:

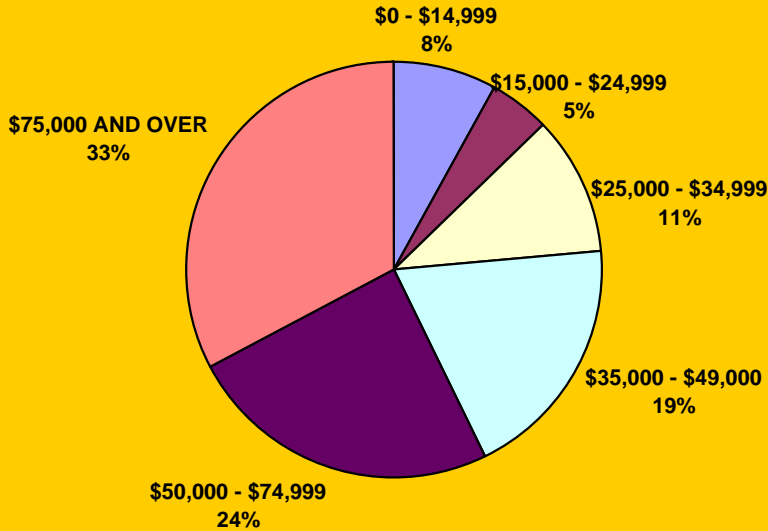

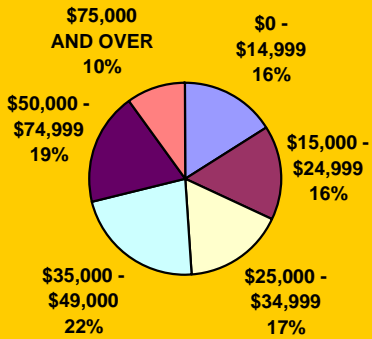

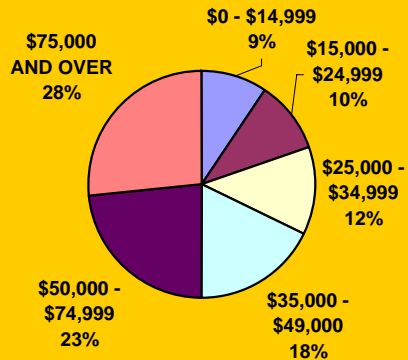
FAMILY INCOME: 2005

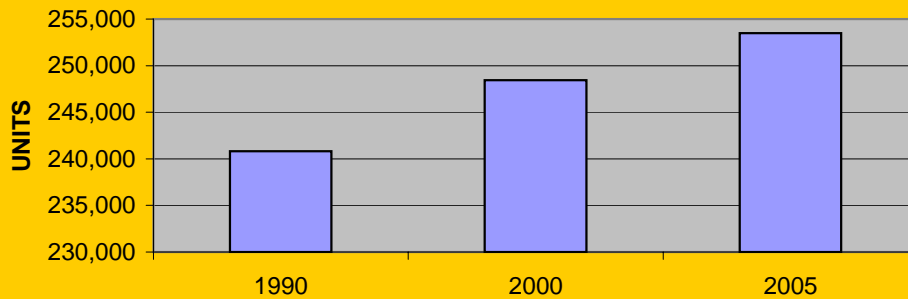

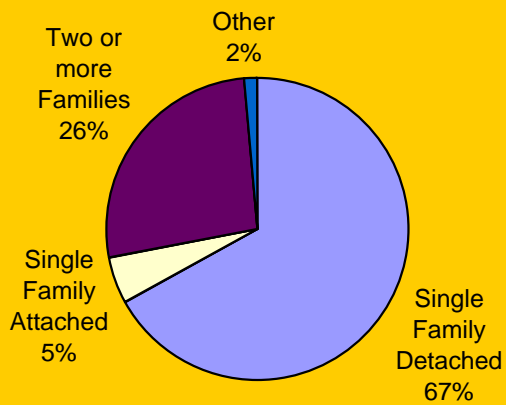

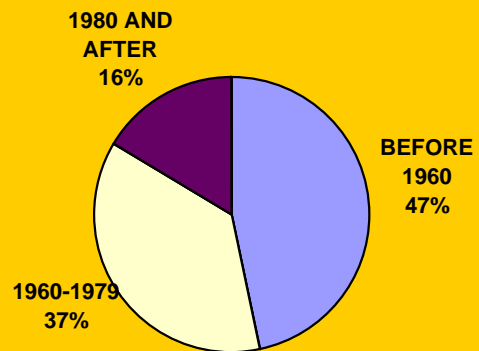
NUMBER OF HOUSING UNITS IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY

DATE OF CONSTRUCTION OF HOUSING: 2005

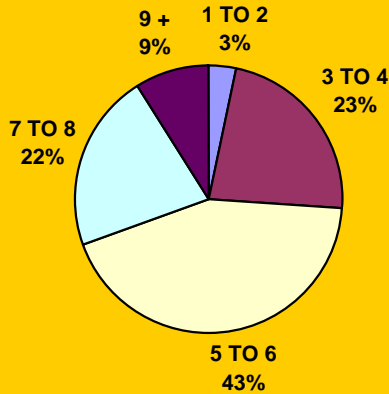

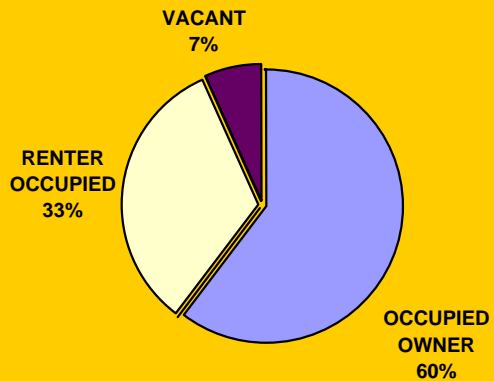

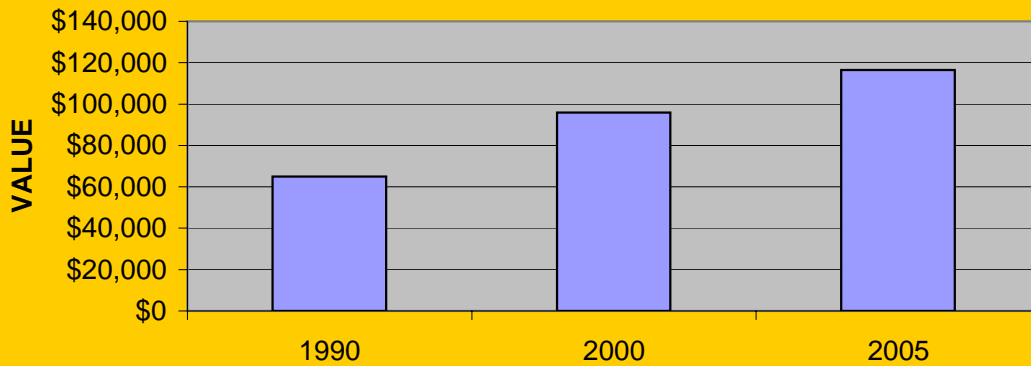
HOUSING UNITS BY ROOMS:2005

MEDIAN VALUE OF HOUSING UNITS IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY

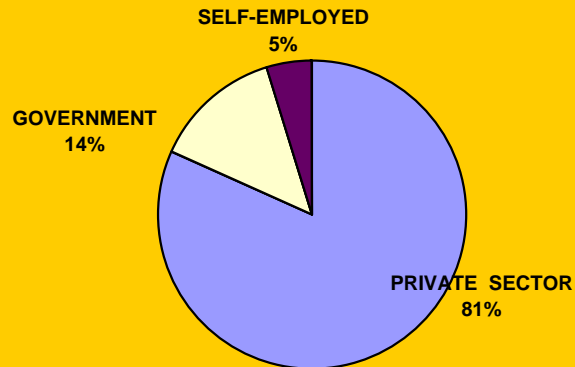

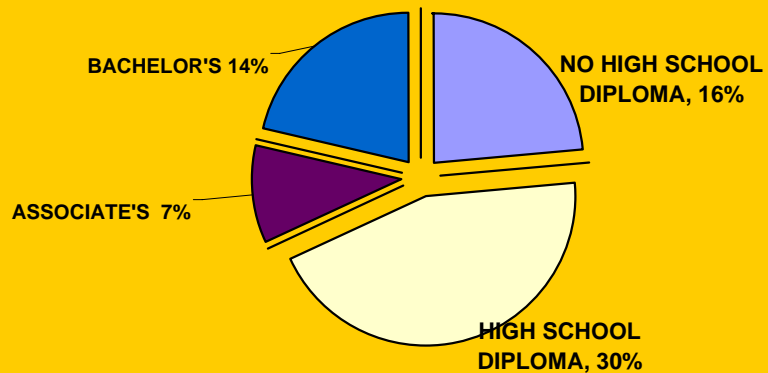

EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT OF POPULATION OVER 25 YEARS OF AGE: 2005

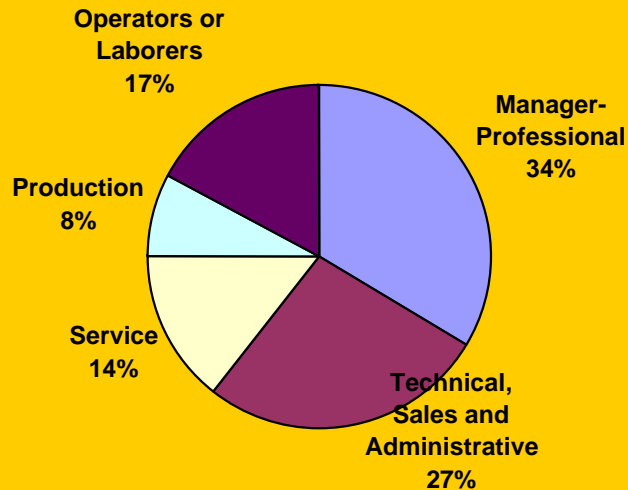

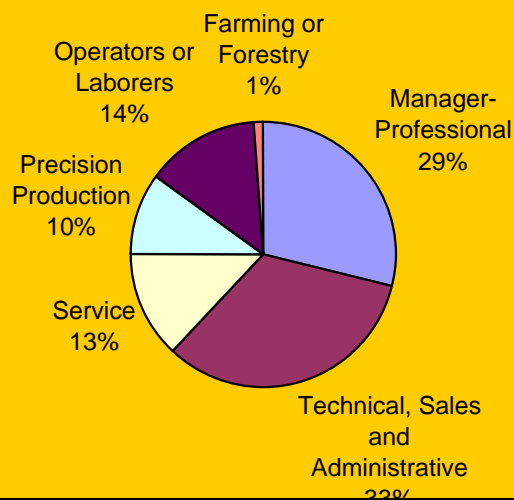
