Definitions

Annual Renewal Demand: Total amount of all of the CoC's projects that are eligible for renewal in the FY2021 CoC Competition.

CoC Bonus: Highly competitive opportunity to apply for one or more new projects (Coordinated Entry, HMIS, Rapid Rehousing, Permanent Supportive Housing) provided a CoC has demonstrated it ranks projects based on how they improve system performance.

DV Bonus: A competitive opportunity to apply for one or more new projects (Coordinated Entry, Joint TH-RRH, Rapid Rehousing) dedicated to survivors of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, or stalking.

Reallocation: Reallocation is a process that CoCs use to shift funds in whole or part from existing eligible renewal projects to create one or more new projects without decreasing the CoC's ARD.
