People: 4,105

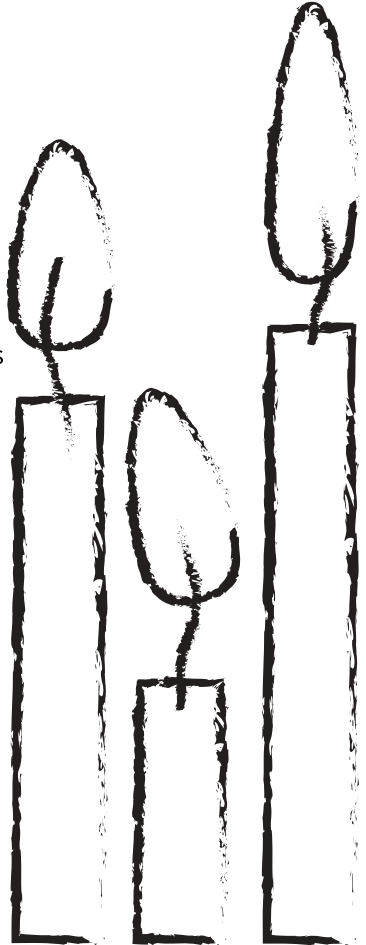
56% - Single Men

8% - Families with Children

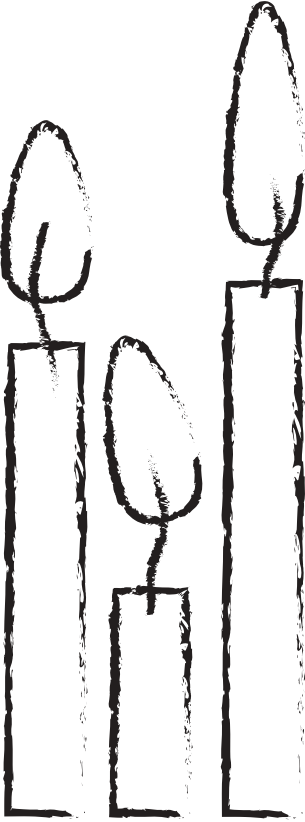
4% - Unaccompanied Minors
