



## VA Claim Checklist for Aid and Attendance

- All DD 214s (Discharges) for all military service served (Original or Certified copy if available)
- Marriage Certificate
- Any previous marriages for both Veteran and spouse of Veteran, need divorce decrees, death certificates, etc.
- If Veteran is **RETIRED MILITARY** a copy of members Retired pay statement.
- If Veteran or spouse of veteran is deceased, a copy of the death certificate.
- **Proof** of all **gross** monthly incomes, Social Security Statements, Pension Statements, interest incomes, etc.
- **Proof** of all current assets, recent statements of all bank accounts, IRA's, Certificates of Deposits, Rental properties, farm properties (income), etc.
- If any supplemental medical insurance is paid out, a copy of that recent statement (unless on Medicaid).
- Social security numbers of Veteran and spouse.
- Bank account number and routing number of bank.

This benefit is **INCOME** and **ASSET** based. It is very important to disclose all income and assets.
