## **Four Co-Defendants Found Guilty in Beating Assault**

***State v. Kamil Abbasov, Izmir Koch, Murad Koch, and Sevil Shakmanov, 2017-CR-1987***

**DAYTON, OH (03/26/2018)** – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that a jury returned guilty as charged verdicts on four co-defendants, after a trial. The four were found guilty of attacking and beating a victim in an incident that occurred on June 7, 2016 in Dayton.

On Tuesday June 7, 2016, the victim was involved in an altercation with the defendants at the place where the defendants worked, SMS Trucking, on Valley Street in Dayton. During the altercation, the defendants attacked and beat the victim with various weapons.

On July 5, 2017, six co-defendants were each indicted on two counts of felonious assault.

A jury trial was held on four of the six defendants, Kamil Abbasov, Izmar Koch, Murad Koch, and Sevil Shakmanov. After deliberations, the jury returned guilty as charged verdicts today.

Co-defendant Mustafa Shakmanov is scheduled for trial on April 2, 2018. The sixth co-defendant, Baris Koch, is scheduled for trial on April 16, 2018.
