Child Support Agency to Offer Services at Area YMCA

DAYTON – Montgomery County’s Child Support Enforcement Agency is reaching out to area parents to help meet the needs of children, and they are venturing outside of their home office to get it done. As part of a new program called *CSEA On The Move*, representatives from the Agency will be at the **Y at the Heights**, 7251 Shull Road, Huber Heights, **Aug. 27 and 30, 3:30 to 5:30 p.m.** each day.

“Working with families is critical because Child Support is about more than just money paid to a custodial parent,” said Sarah Fields, Assistant Director, Montgomery County CSEA. “We can facilitate visitation agreements because children do better with two involved parents. We can also help with employment and other barriers to self-sufficiency. This is why we are getting into area communities with CSEA On The Move -- to show people that we want to help.”

While at the Y and the Heights, CSEA workers will be sharing information about free paternity testing, employment and parenting resources, support establishment, modifying support orders, payment options and more.
