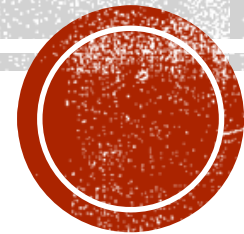

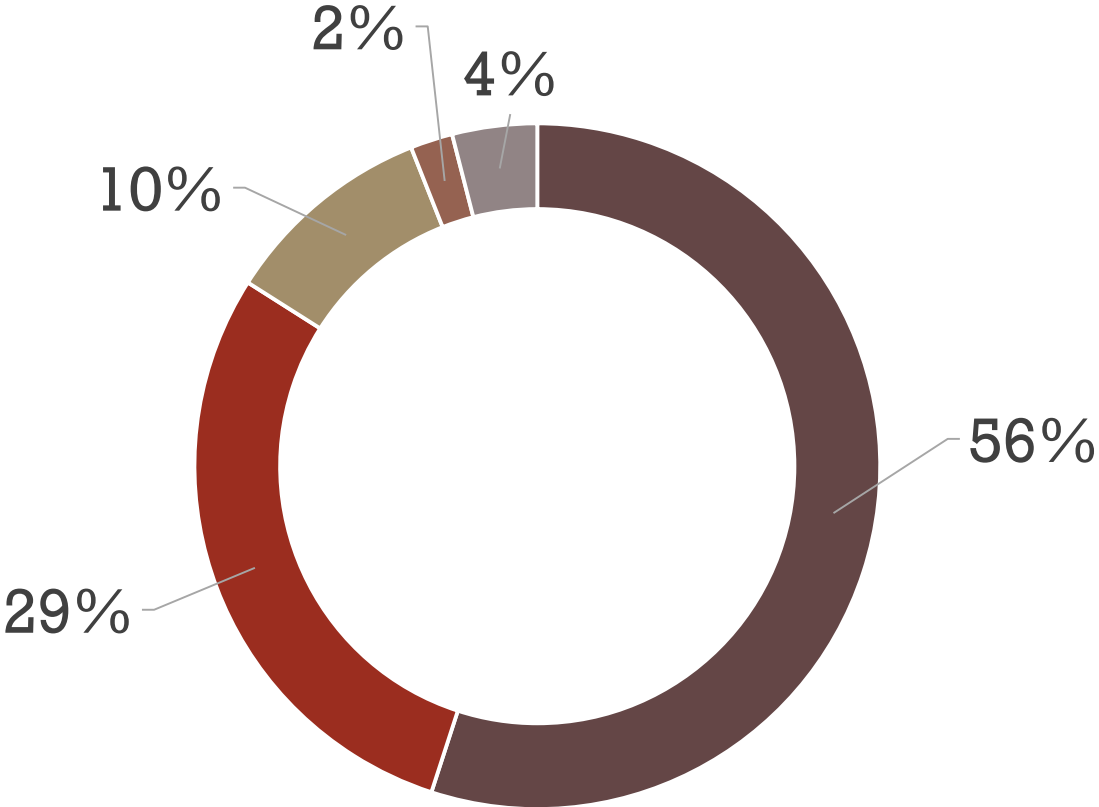

Front Door Household Types 2019



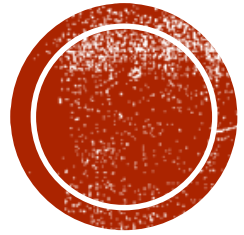

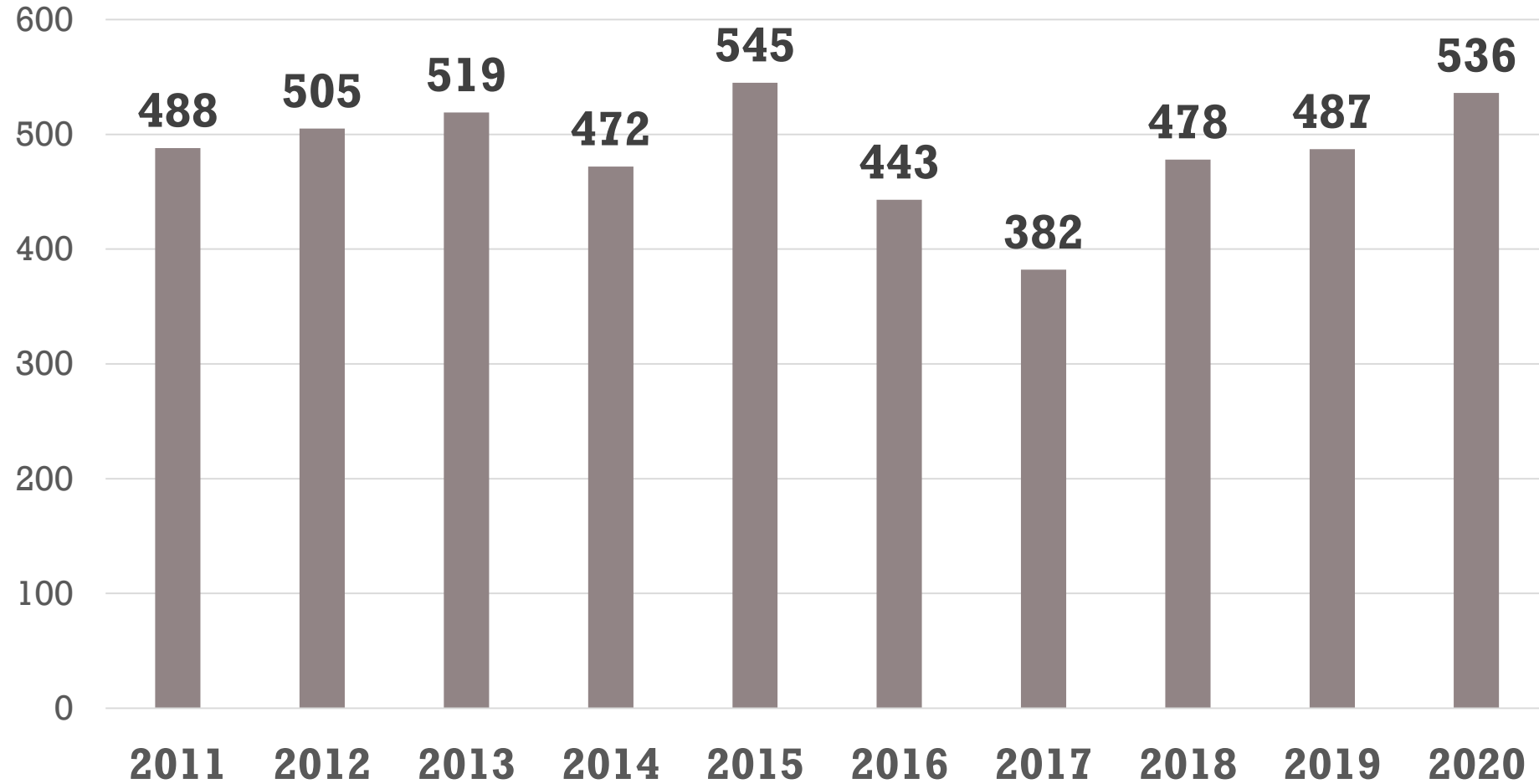

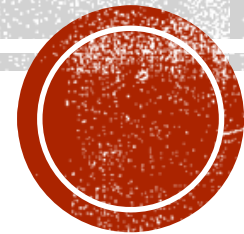


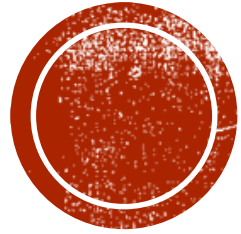
PIT COUNT HOUSEHOLDS 2011-2020

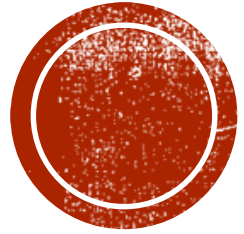

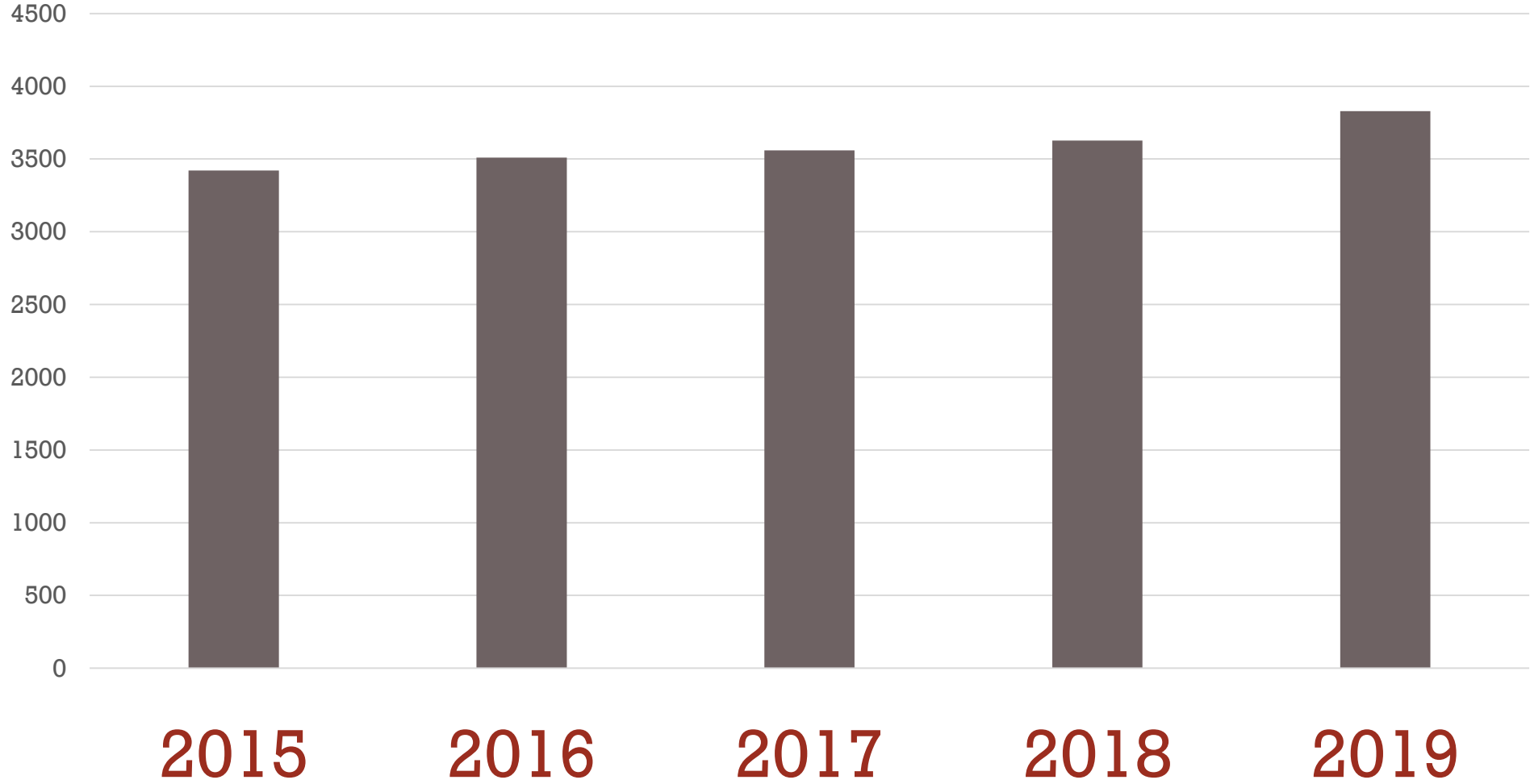


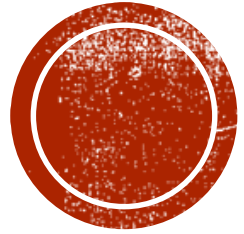

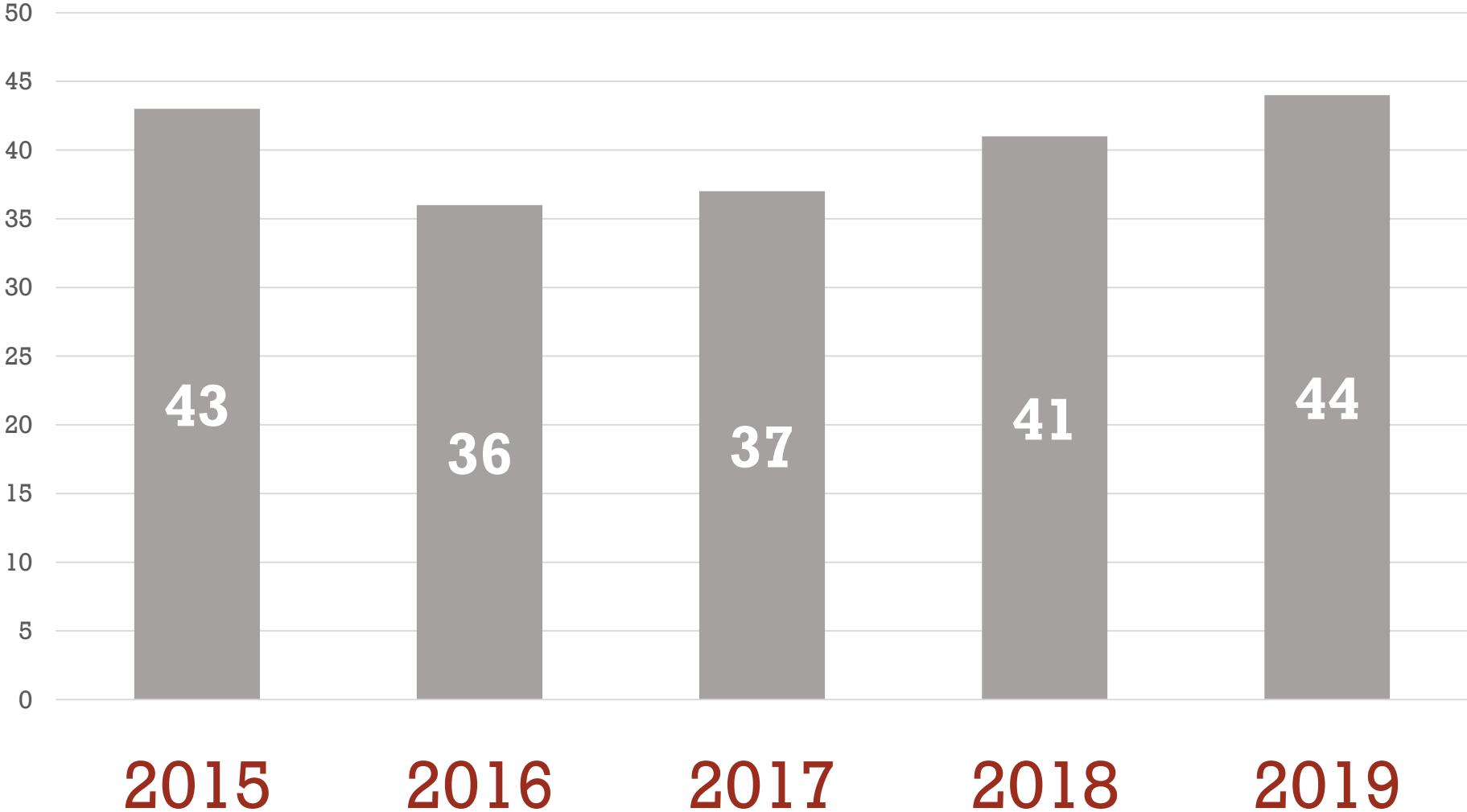


LENGTH OF STAY

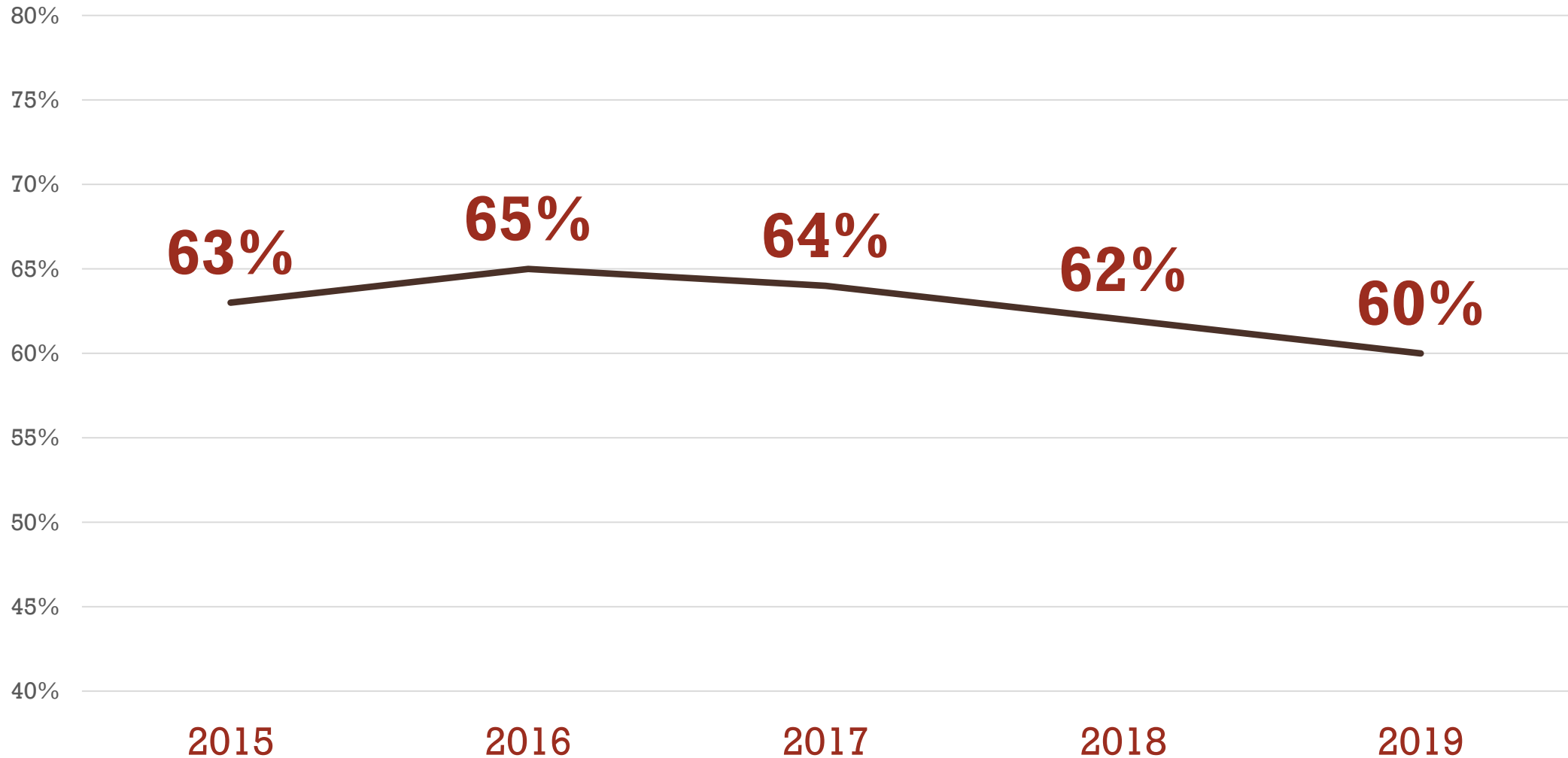

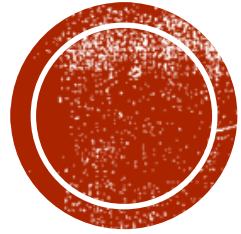
AVERAGE LENGTH OF STAY IN SHELTER

Percentage of Adult Households



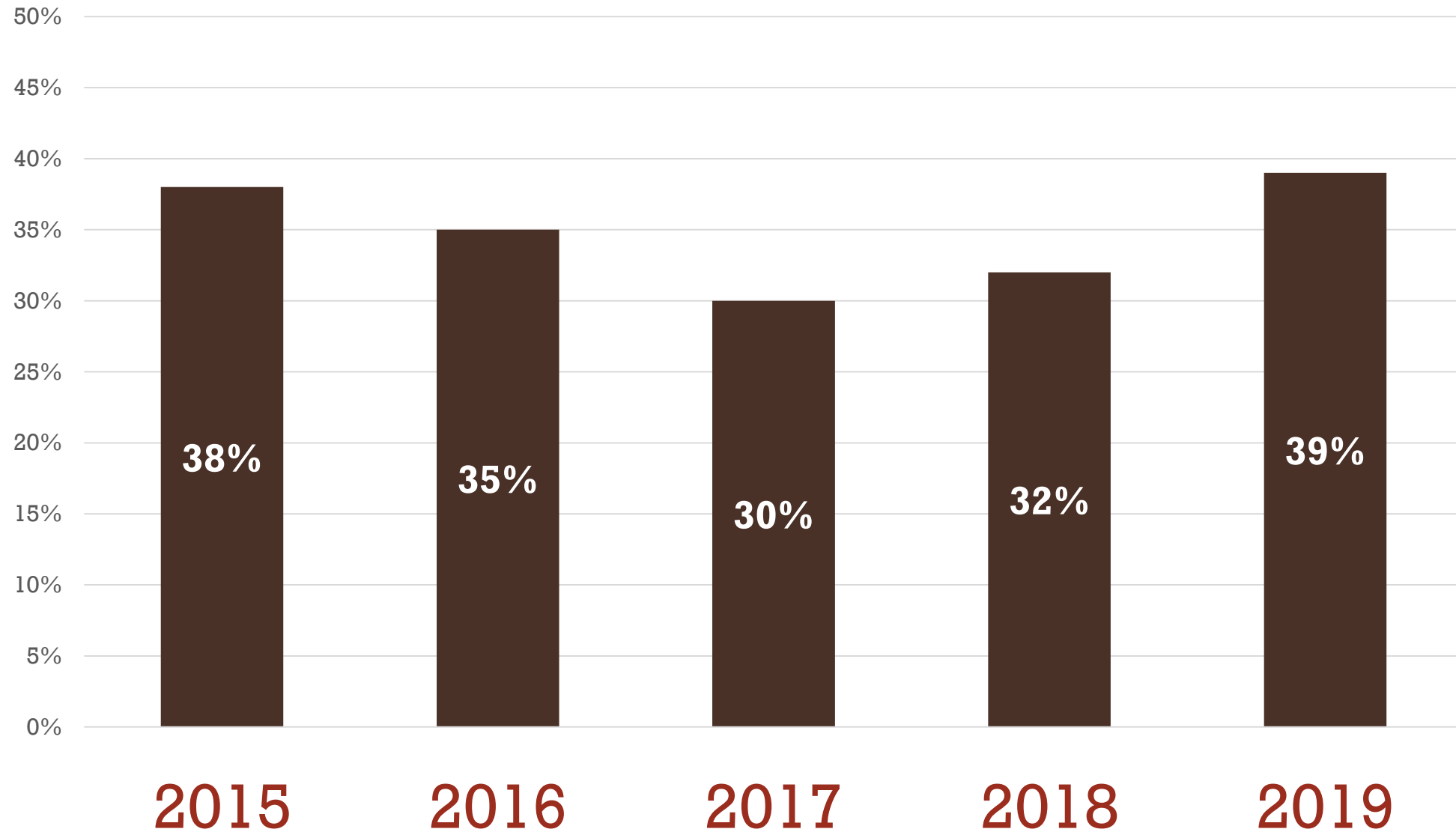


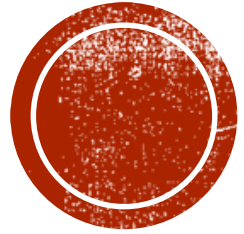

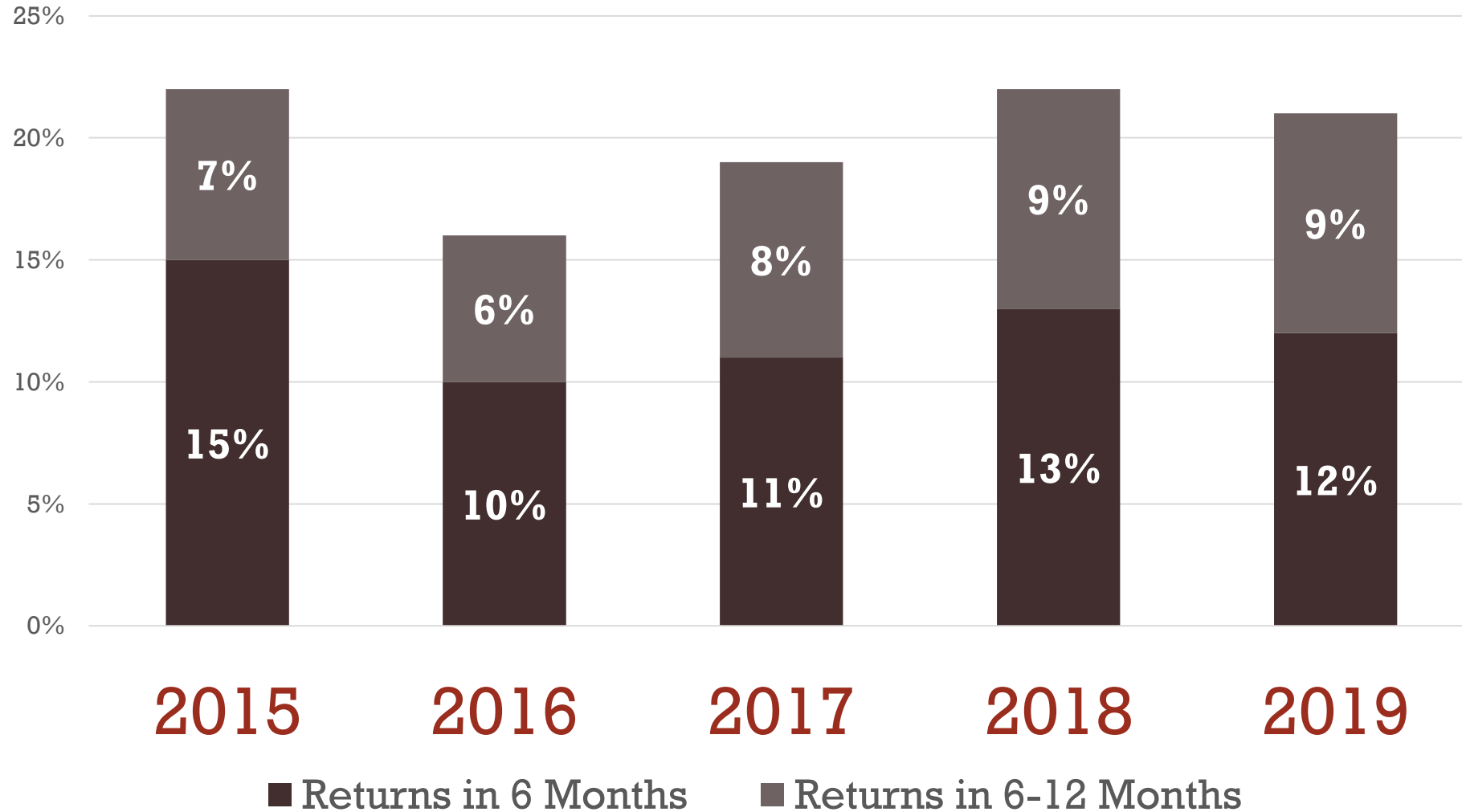

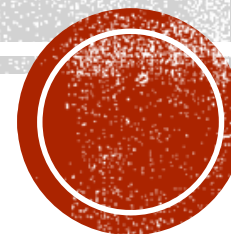

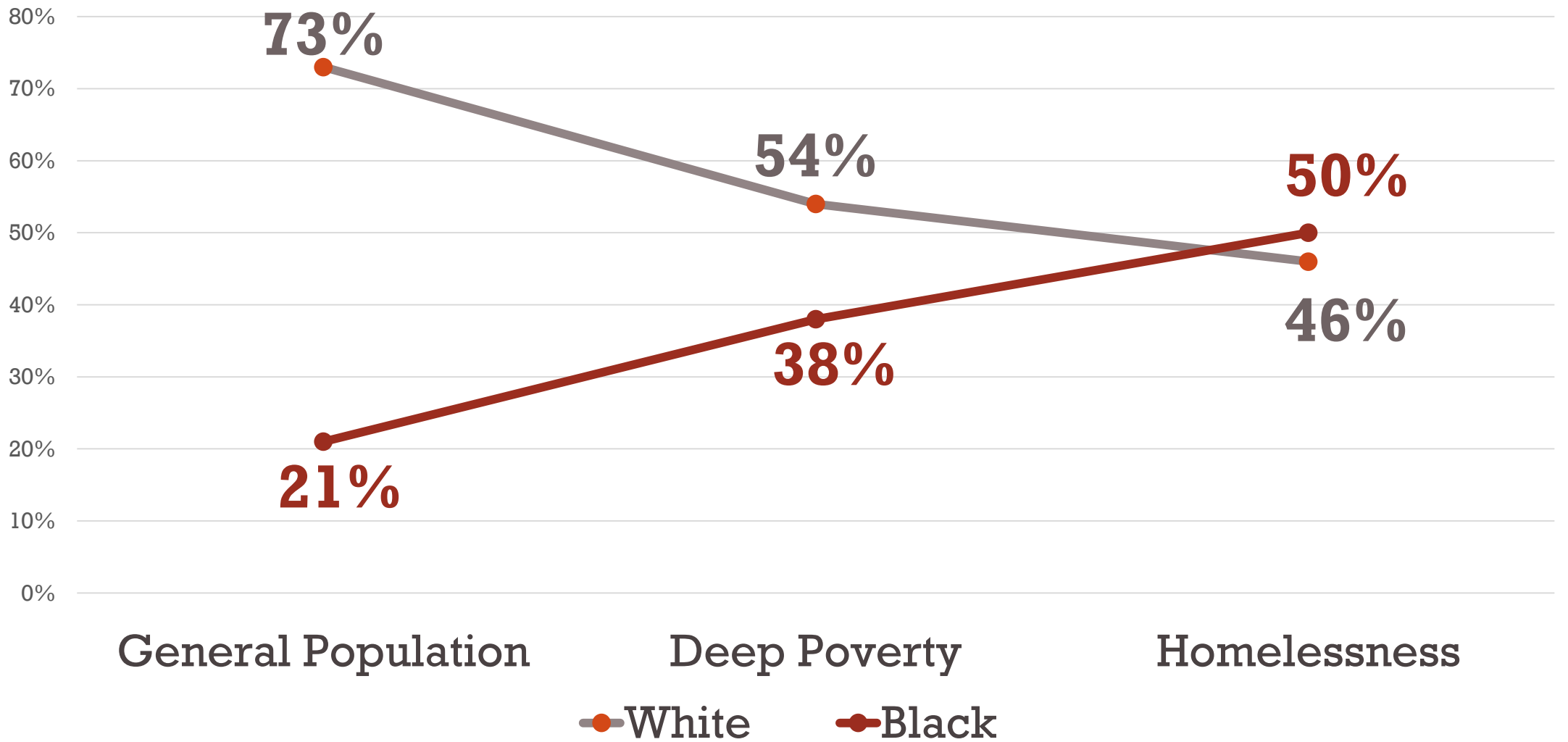

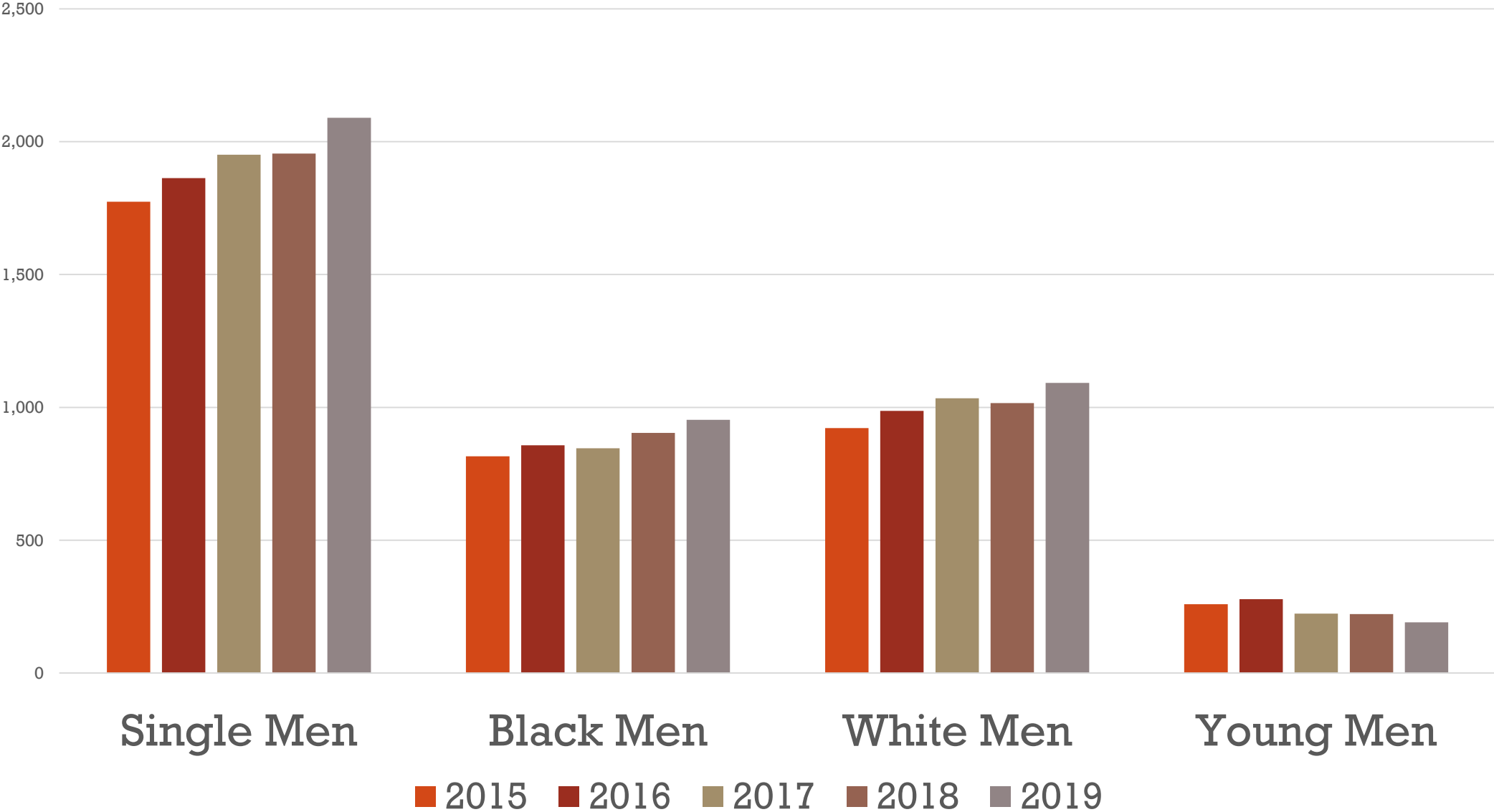


PERSONS EXPERIENCING HOMELESSNESS BY RACE

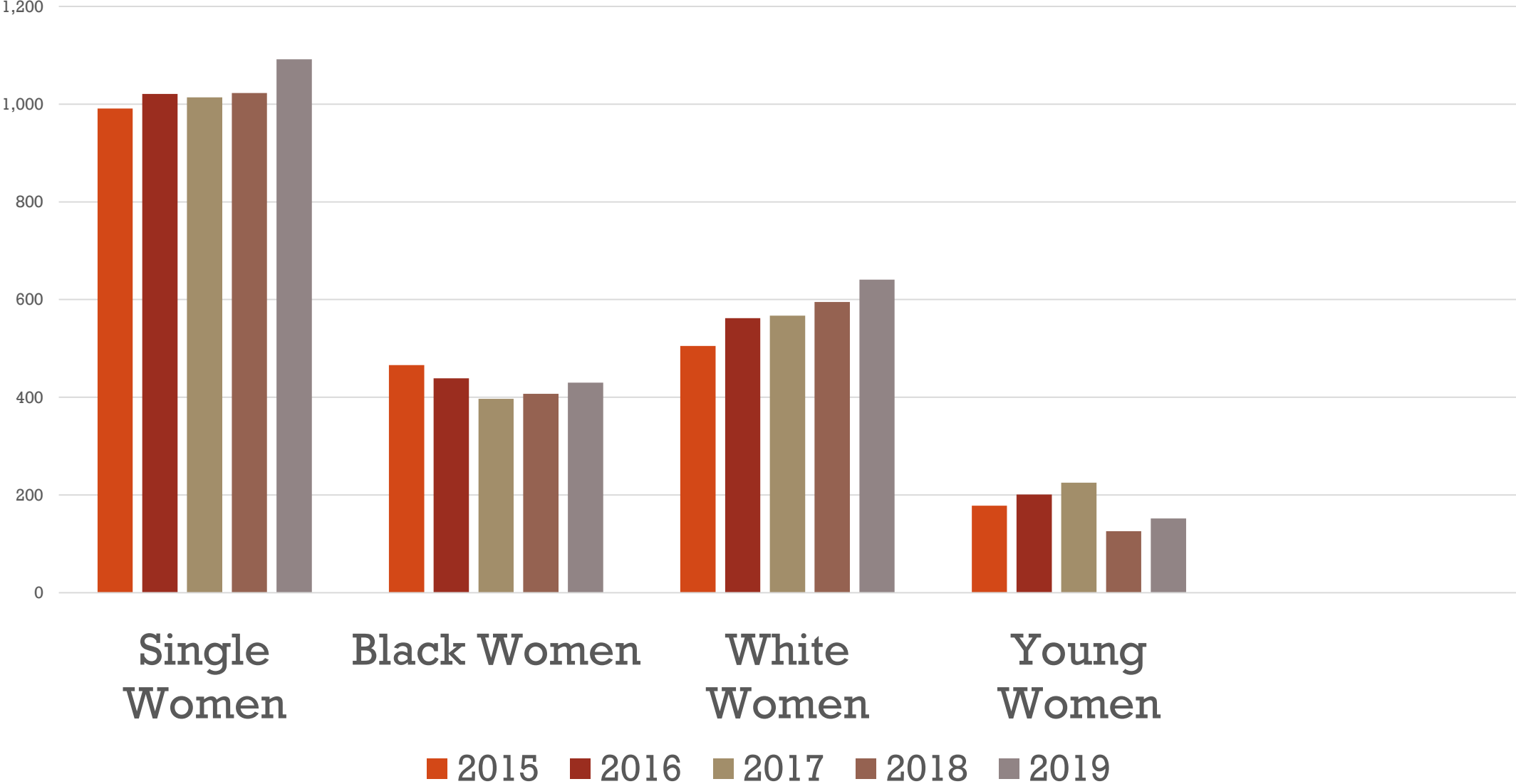

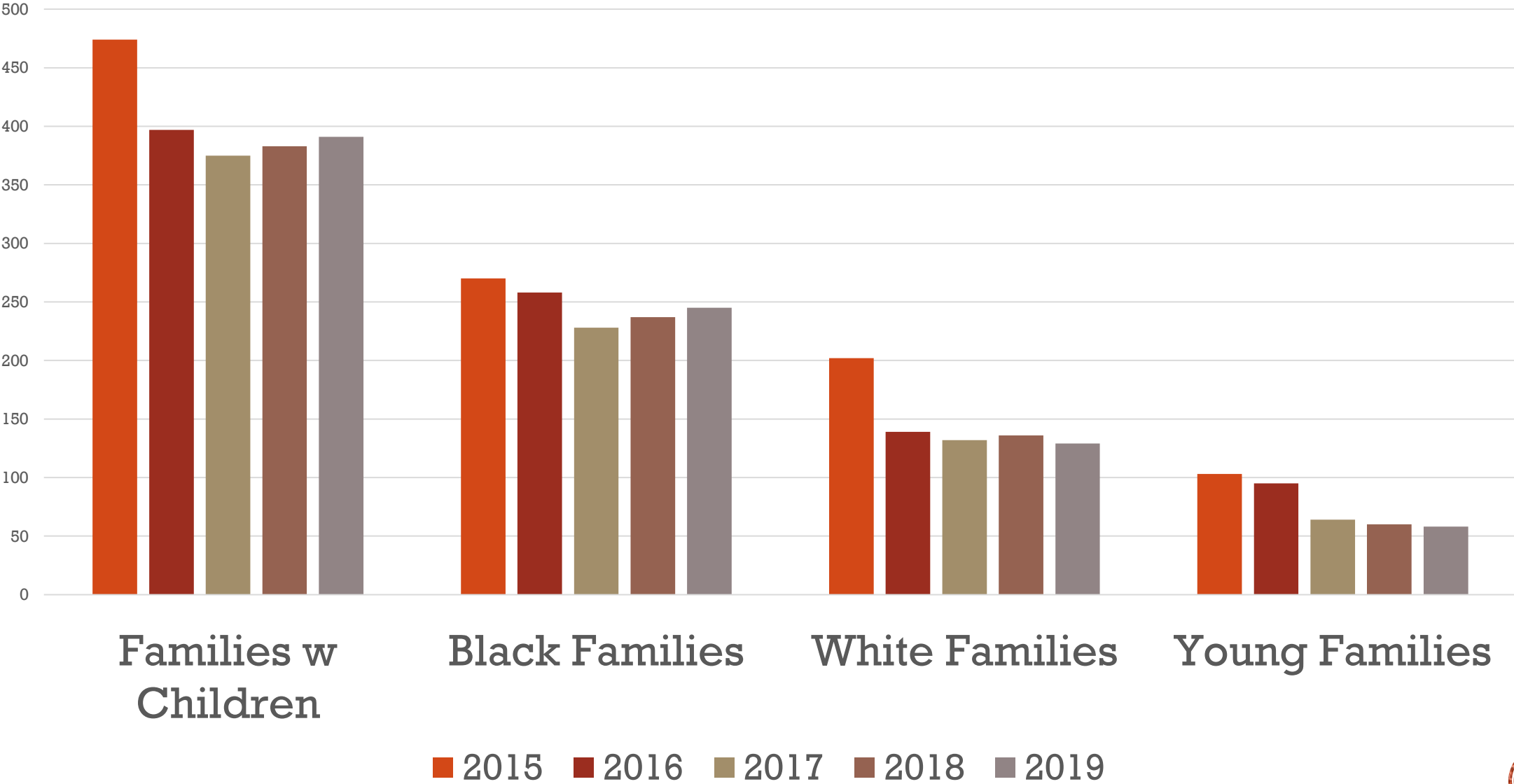
SINGLE MEN 2015-2019

FAMILIES WITH CHILDREN 2015-2019

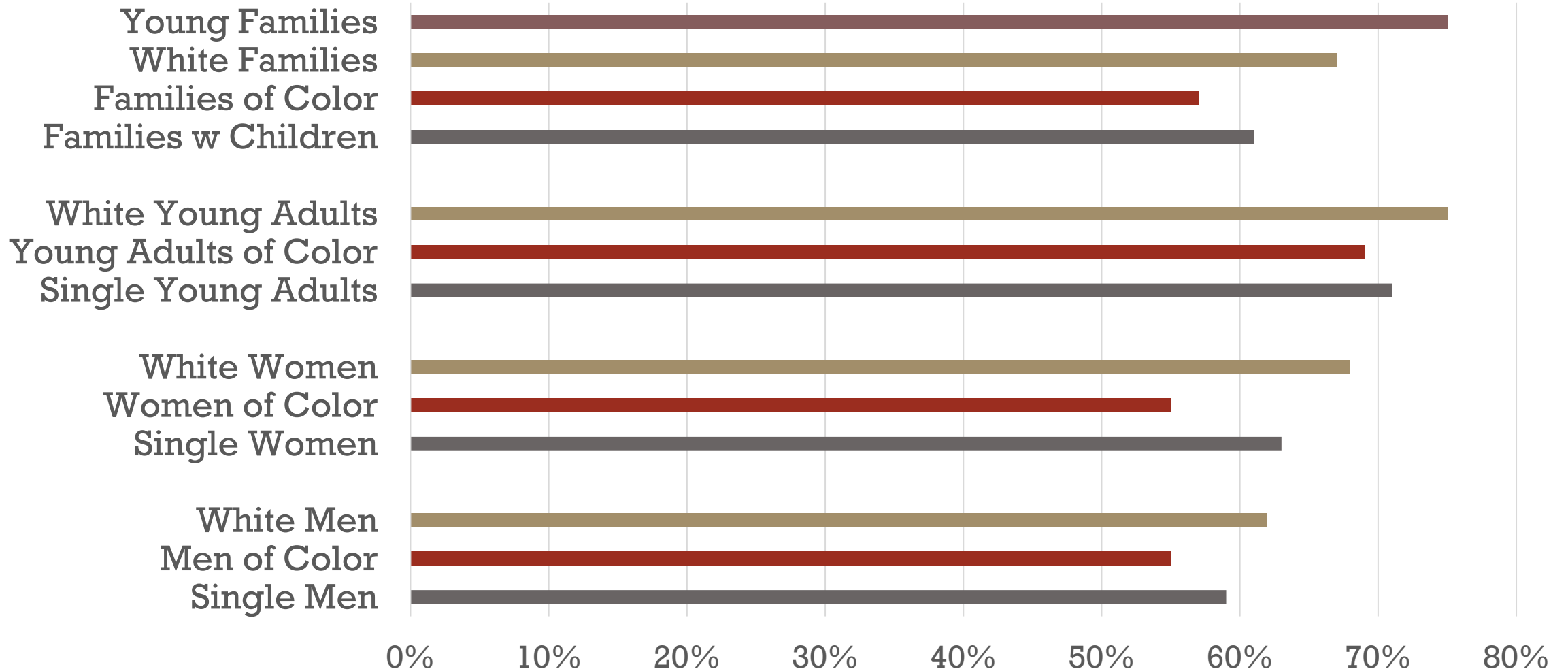
