Background

2007 – Environmental Services began sponsoring blood drives

2008 – Montgomery County began sponsoring the maximum 6 blood drives per year

Our blood drive provides a community service by being open to the public.

Our blood drives have a 105% accuracy rate.



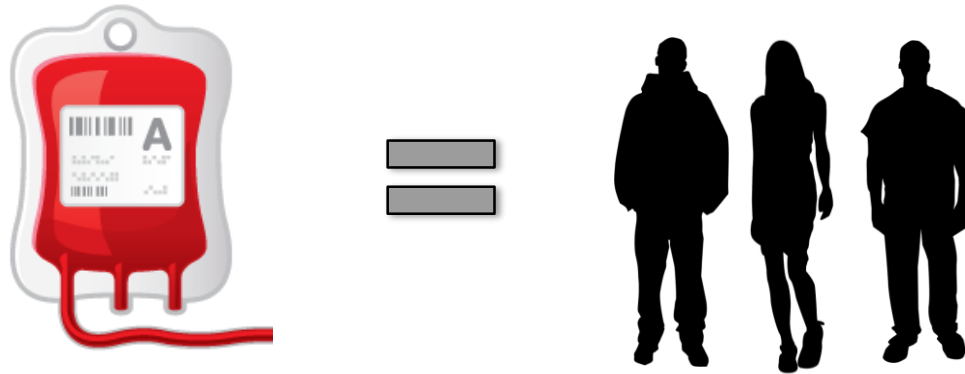
Impact Report

- We have sponsored 50 blood drives.
- More than 1,680 people have donated blood (equivalent to more than 1,680 volunteer hours).



Impact Report

1,472 units of blood have been donated.

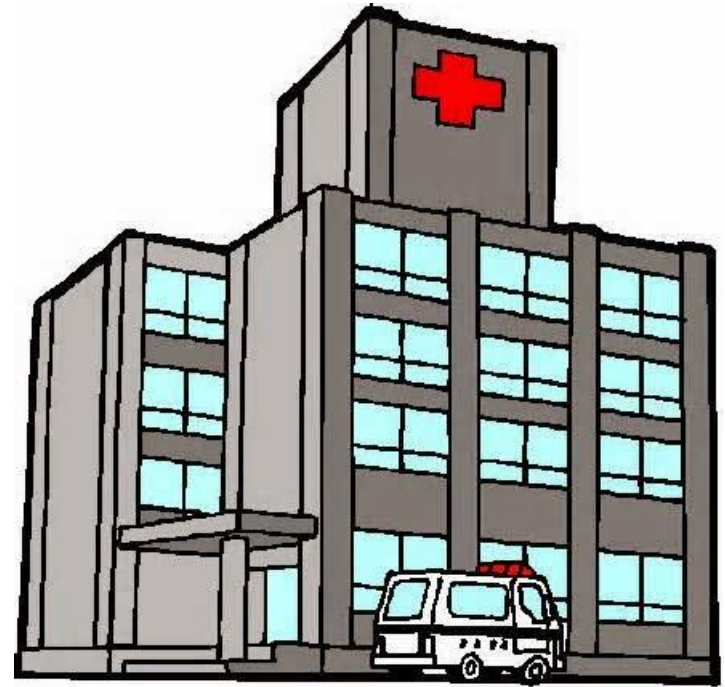


Potentially, **more than 4,400 lives** have been saved in our community by MCES blood drives.



Importance of Blood Drives

- Community Blood Center (CBC) serves 15 counties and 24 hospitals.
- CBC needs up to 300 donors per day to maintain hospital blood supply.
- There is no substitute for human blood.



How You Can Donate

To schedule an appointment to donate blood at Montgomery County Environmental Services, go to www.donortime.com and enter code: 186

Or donate at our **Community Blood Center** located at 349 S. Main Street, Dayton, OH 45402.

- You have to be at least 17 years old to donate blood, or 16 years old with a parental consent.
- You must weigh at least 110 lb.
- You must be in general good health.

- ✓ Collected 155 units of blood
