 - a. Incidents started in April -Status of current projects
 - Incident in Harrison Township-fatal accident- tractor trailer turned over- several thousand gallons of high fructose corn syrup
 - Reminder that anything that gets into the drain is a call out to hazmat
 - Technical advisory committee is back to having monthly meetings in Columbus
 - Exercise exemption for 2022 was granted by the state
 - Sugarcreek packing was the host for the training
 - HME funding request was submitted to MCOEM- STTS is the trainer- 407 tanker

- Specs were submitted for hazmat truck was submitted for bid
- August- Beavercreek training at Soyne Medical
- September- STTS
- October-Dayton Bomb Squad
- November-Ohio EPA
- Researching new equipment for purchase
- Jeff confirmed that Sam knows when the exercises are
- Gary reminded that a notice is required by state for exercises-30-day and 60-day notices are sent out- state reps are present as evaluators

 - Gary responded and said yes, he does not see that changing at this point.
