The Real Estate module offered in the **Lexis Practice Advisor** will be added to the Lexis subscription. It contains transactional content including term sheets, annotated agreements and letters of intent, as well as leading real estate treatises and sample forms and documents from The American Institute of Architects.

Practical Law, to be added to our Westlaw subscription, provides practice notes, templates, and workflow tools for all major practice areas. Included are multi-jurisdictional guides to compare laws across jurisdictions, an automated drafting tool for documents, as well as updates and current awareness for various topics.
