	Decreased Binge Drinking	Calculated based on the response to 2 Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System questions.
	Increased Employment Rate for Persons with Disability	Employment rate for persons age 16 and older with a disability

Income and Stability	Increased Avoidance of Poverty	Percentage of first births where both parents completed high school, are married (at any time from conception to birth) and both parents are at least 20 years old
	Decreased Concentrated Poverty	Percentage of residents with incomes below 50% of the Federal Poverty Line
	Decreased People Receiving Public Assistance	Percent of households receiving temporary assistance to needy families
	Increased Median Household Income	Median household income (in constant dollars)
	Decreased Unemployment	Unemployment rate
	Increased Stable Employment	Percentage of population (16-64 years old) working 35+ hours/week for 40+ weeks/year
	Decreased Abandoned Housing	Abandoned housing as a percentage of total housing units
	Decreased Homelessness	Households spending at least one night in shelter or unsheltered
