



Recycle Right Video Contest

Rules and Guidelines

Background

Recycling is changing, and it's important to RECYCLE RIGHT in your curbside bin. Paper, cardboard, glass, plastic bottles and jugs, and metal cans are all recyclable materials at curbside. Your challenge is to create a **30 second video** highlighting proper items to RECYCLE RIGHT in Montgomery County.

Who Can Enter?

The contest is open to all Montgomery County students in grades 9-12 during the 2020-2021 academic year. Students may enter the contest as one individual or as a team of up to four.

Contest Deadline

All videos must be submitted by 4 p.m. Friday, October 16, 2020.

Video Specifications

Videos must be no longer than 30 seconds in length.

Use of copyrighted video, music, images, logos, and trademarks is prohibited. Entries that contain these materials will be disqualified.

How to Submit Your Entry

1. Upload your completed video to YouTube.
2. Complete one Registration Form per entry.
3. Complete one Media Permission Waiver per student participant. Permission waivers must be signed by a parent or guardian. If multiple students are collaborating on an entry, each student will need to submit a completed media permission waiver.
4. Email your video link, Registration Form, and Media Permission Waiver(s) to shepherdj@mcoho.org. You will receive a confirmation email once your completed entry has been received.

Team Submissions

Videos may be created by one individual or by teams of up to four.

Use of Submitted Videos

Montgomery County reserves the right to use and own all submitted media.

Judging and Prizes

Entries will be judged by a committee composed of Montgomery County Environmental Services staff. Judges will evaluate each entry on:

- How well the entry conveys the message of Recycle Right in Montgomery County.
- Creativity
- Originality
- Quality
- Overall impression

All of the above will be considered when selecting the contest winner.

The top three videos will be featured on the Montgomery County Solid Waste District webpage, as well as County social media outlets.

Second and third prize winners will receive tickets to a 2021 Dayton Dragons game, an award plaque, and will be recognized at a meeting of the Montgomery County Commissioners.

The grand prize winner will receive the opportunity to have their winning video idea professionally filmed. The final video will air on local television and will be played during a Dayton Dragons game.
