**Co-defendant Sentenced for Harrison Township Home Invasion**

*State v. Jarrelle Anderson, 2019-CR-4052*

**DAYTON, OH (1/21/2020)** – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **JARRELLE EARL ANDERSON**, 21, of Dayton, was sentenced to a total range of 12 to 15 years in prison after being convicted on counts in connection to an armed home invasion that occurred on November 26, 2019, in Harrison Township.

On the night of Tuesday, November 26, 2019, the defendant, a co-defendant, Darrius Pattson, and a juvenile went to a residence on Monroe Avenue in Harrison Township. Defendant Pattson kicked open the door and both adult defendants entered the home brandishing firearms. The defendants held the two adult residents and two of their children, ages five and two, at gunpoint. The defendants ransacked the home, taking firearms, cash, and other items before fleeing.

On January 6, 2021, the defendant was found guilty of:

- Two counts of Aggravated Robbery
- One count of Aggravated Burglary
- One count of Kidnapping
- One count of Having Weapons While Under Disability – prior offense of violence
- Two counts of Aggravated Menacing

Today, the defendant was sentenced to a total range of 12 to 15 years in prison.

On December 30, 2020, co-defendant Pattson was also sentenced to a range of 12-15 years in prison for his actions.
