64-Year-Old Trotwood Man Sentenced for Manslaughter

State v. Randall Aniton, 2019-CR-4195

DAYTON, OH (11/24/2020) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **RANDALL ANITON**, 64, of Trotwood, was sentenced to 8 years in prison after being convicted of involuntary manslaughter for the shooting death of Myron Taylor which occurred on December 21, 2019.

On Saturday, December 21, 2019, Trotwood police officers responded to a home on Northford Road on a report of a shooting. When officers arrived, the defendant told them that he had shot the victim, 53-year-old Myron Taylor, of Dayton. The defendant was secured in a cruiser and the officers entered the home and located the deceased body of the victim, who had been shot two times.

Further investigation determined that the defendant shot the victim after a brief altercation.

On November 4, 2020, the defendant was found guilty on one count of Involuntary Manslaughter, plus a 3-year firearm specification.

Today, the defendant was sentenced to a total of 8 years in prison.
