Ms. Gramza received her law degree from The Ohio State University College of Law in 2000. She received her undergraduate degree from Miami University, in Oxford, Ohio, majoring in Diplomacy and Foreign Affairs, with a minor in Economics.

Ann was an Assistant Prosecuting Attorney in Shelby County, Ohio from August 2002 to April 2005. She was then a Montgomery County Assistant Prosecuting Attorney from April 2005 until March 2013 and served as the Supervising Attorney of the Child Protection Unit from January 2011 to March 2013. Then, from March 2013 until her return to our office, Ann was the CASA Program Manager at the Montgomery County Juvenile Court.

Ann is assigned to the Intake/Grand Jury Section of the Prosecutor's Office. The Intake/Grand Jury Section is comprised of assistant prosecuting attorney whose primary responsibility is conducting Preliminary Hearings in the municipal courts as well as presenting cases for indictment before the Montgomery County Grand Jury.
