**Three Indicted for Deadly Home Invasion**  
*State v. Daylequan Arnold, Deon Harris, and King Turner, 2020-CR-825*

**DAYTON, OH (06/03/2020)** – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **DAYLEQUAN S, ARNOLD, Jr.**, 23, **DEON M. HARRIS, Jr.**, 27, and **KING A. TURNER**, 21, all of Dayton, have been indicted for counts in connection to a home invasion that occurred on Saturday, December 21, 2019, in which two victims were fatally shot.

During the early morning hours of Saturday, December 21, 2019, Dayton police were dispatched on a report of a shooting at a residence in the 900 block of Ethel Avenue in Dayton. Upon arrival, they located a deceased victim, who had been shot multiple times, later identified as Frankie McGee, Jr. In another room, a second shooting victim was found and was transported to the hospital. The second victim, identified as Christopher Huntley, died from his injuries on December 28, 2019.

The investigation, including video surveillance and other forensic evidence, revealed the defendants forced their way into the home in order to commit a burglary. During the commission of the burglary, both victims were shot multiple times.

Today, the Montgomery County Grand Jury indicted the each of the defendants for:

- Two counts of Aggravated Murder
- Four counts of Murder
- Four counts of Aggravated Burglary
- Four counts of Felonious Assault

All of the counts also include 3-year firearm specifications. Additionally, defendant Harris was indicted on one count of Having Weapons While Under Disability, and defendant Turner was indicted on two counts of Having Weapons While Under Disability.

Warrants have been issued for the arrest of the defendants. They will be arraigned on Thursday, June 18, 2020, at 8:30 a.m.
