Dayton Man Indicted for Killing Ex-Girlfriend; Shooting Another Man

State v. John Bailey 2016-CR-1148

DAYTON, OH (04/20/2016) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **John B. Bailey**, 22, of Dayton, has been indicted for fatally shooting his ex-girlfriend and shooting another man, inside a Trotwood apartment on April 10, 2016.

On Sunday, April 10, 2016, police received a 911 call informing them of a shooting inside an apartment at Meadowlark Apartments, 4826 Biddison Avenue, in Trotwood. Police responded and found a 22-year-old man suffering from multiple gunshots. Police also located a second, deceased, shooting victim in an upstairs bedroom. She was identified as 24-year-old Tayisha Gibson.

The defendant is reportedly the ex-boyfriend of the deceased female victim.

Today, the defendant was indicted for:

- Two counts of Murder
- Four counts of Felonious Assault
- One count of Having Weapons While Under Disability for a prior offense of violence

The murder and felonious assault counts carry a mandatory 3-year firearm specification because the defendant used a firearm during the commission of his crimes.

The defendant will be arraigned on April 26, 2016 at 8:30 am. He is currently in custody, being held on a \$500,000 bond.
