## **Dayton Woman Indicted for Striking Ex-Boyfriend With Vehicle**

*State v. Lisa Baker, 2016-CR-1643*

**DAYTON, OH (06/06/2016)** – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **Lisa R. Baker**, 44, of Dayton, has been indicted for assaulting her ex-boyfriend with a motor vehicle on May 28, 2016.

Shortly before 3:00 a.m. on Saturday, May 28, 2016, Dayton Police and paramedics were dispatched to the 900 block of Neal Avenue on a report of a pedestrian having been struck by a motor vehicle. They located the victim, who was unresponsive and suffering from critical injuries, and transported him to the hospital.

The investigation and witness statements determined that the defendant and victim had been boyfriend/girlfriend. They had been out at a club with some friends earlier that evening when they reportedly got into an argument. During the argument, the defendant got into the vehicle and purposely drove it towards the victim, striking him. When police arrived, they took the defendant into custody.

Today, the defendant has been indicted on:

- One count of Felonious Assault With a Deadly Weapon
- One count of Felonious Assault Causing Serious Harm

The defendant is currently in custody, being held on a \$50,000 bond. She will be arraigned on June 9, 2016 at 8:30 a.m.
