**Convicted Felon Indicted for Murder**

*State v. Emanuel Belton, 2013-CR-1639*

**DAYTON, OH (06/30/2015)** – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that 31-year-old **Emanuel L. Belton** has been indicted for the shooting death of Terence Williams on January 28, 2013.

On January 28, 2013, the defendant shot and killed the victim, who was the on-again/off-again boyfriend of the defendant's sister. The shooting occurred inside the Miami Township home of the defendant's sister, after an altercation between the defendant and the victim.

The defendant was arrested by the U.S. Marshalls in Davidson County, Tennessee in December, 2014. He was extradited to Montgomery County and has been in custody ever since. The defendant has three prior convictions for carrying concealed weapons, and is currently on trial in an unrelated case for committing an aggravated robbery of a Clark Oil station in April, 2013 in Huber Heights.

Today, the defendant was indicted on:

- Two counts of Murder
- Two counts of Aggravated Robbery
- Two counts of Felonious Assault

The defendant is scheduled to be arraigned on July 2, 2015 at 8:30 a.m.
