Dayton Woman Indicted for Murder of Riverside Man
State v. Sarah Bierma, 2021-CR-2094

DAYTON, OH (07/01/2021) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **SARAH M. BIERMA**, 38, of Dayton, has been indicted on counts in connection to the murder of 60-year-old Kendall Combs, whose deceased body was discovered on June 21, 2021 inside his home in Riverside.

On Monday, June 21, 2021, a relative of the victim was concerned about being unable to contact him. The relative went to the victim's home and discovered his deceased body in the kitchen. Riverside police and medics were dispatched to the home in the 300 block of Wendell Lane. Upon arrival, the victim's body was located and the victim appeared to have been stabbed with a pair of scissors.

The relative of the victim reported to investigators that the victim's cellphone was missing. The police "pinged" the phone and discovered it was still turned on and was located in another part of Riverside. Police responded to the location of the phone and found it was in the possession of the defendant.

Today, the Montgomery County Grand Jury has indicted the defendant for:

- Two counts of Murder
- Two counts of Felonious Assault
- One count of Aggravated Burglary
- One count of Aggravated Robbery
- One count of Tampering with Evidence

The defendant will be arraigned on Tuesday, July 6, 2021, at 8:30 a.m.
