Dayton Man Indicted for Causing Three Traffic Crashes, One Fatality

State v. Walter Shane Bradley, 2016 CR 2391

DAYTON, OH (11/23/2016) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **WALTER SHANE BRADLEY**, 33, of Dayton, has been indicted on multiple charges in connection with a series of traffic crashes in downtown Dayton on August 22, 2015, that resulted in one fatality.

On the evening of Saturday, August 22, 2015, the defendant, driving a Ford F-150 pickup truck, struck two vehicles at the intersection of East Third Street at St. Clair Street in downtown Dayton and struck another vehicle at the intersection of East First Street at Keowee Street. Then, while traveling in excess of 60 mph, he struck a fourth vehicle broadside, at the intersection of Taylor and Monument Streets, killing the other driver, 22-year-old Kirstin Burton, upon impact. Ms. Burton's 13-month-old child, who was restrained in a child safety seat in the rear seat of her vehicle, was transported to Dayton Children's Hospital with life-threatening injuries. The defendant's blood-alcohol content was determined to be nearly three times the legal limit. At the time of the incidents, the defendant did not have a valid driver's license.

Today, the defendant has been indicted on:

- Four counts of Aggravated Vehicular Homicide
- Two counts of Aggravated Vehicular Assault
- Two counts of Vehicular Assault
- Two counts of Failure to Stop After an Accident or Collision
- Two counts of Failure to Stop After Accident

A warrant has been issued for the arrest of the defendant. He is scheduled to be arraigned on December 8, 2016 at 8:30 a.m.
