Dayton Woman Found Guilty and Sentenced for Homicide

State v. Jazzmon Brooks, 2018-CR-3809

DAYTON, OH (01/08/2020) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **JAZZMON MARIE BROOKS**, 37, of Dayton, has been sentenced to 18 years-to-life in prison after being found guilty on counts for the shooting death of Timothy Truesdale, whose body was discovered on September 22, 2018.

On Saturday, September 22, 2018, Dayton Police officers responded to an apartment on Hunter Avenue on a tip that there could be a deceased body inside. Upon entering the apartment, the officers discovered the deceased body of the victim, 40-year-old Timothy Truesdale. The victim's body was located in a bathroom, partially wrapped in a shower curtain. It was obvious the victim had been dead for a while. An autopsy later determined the victim died from a gunshot wound.

Further investigation determined that the defendant had shot the victim.

On April 12, 2019, the Montgomery County Grand Jury indicted the defendant. Today, the defendant entered a guilty plea to Murder, two counts of Tampering With Evidence, two counts of Having Weapons While Under Disability, and one count of Gross Abuse of a Corpse.

The defendant was sentenced to a total of 18 years-to-life in prison. She will not be eligible for the consideration of parole until she has served at least 18 years.
