**Dayton Man Indicted for Wife's Murder**  
*State v. Tremayne Burdine, 2020-CR-3593*

**DAYTON, OH (01/25/2021)** – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **TREMAYNE LEE BURDINE**, 38, of Dayton, has been indicted on counts in connection to the shooting death of his wife, 30-year-old Tenisha Burdine, on November 14, 2020.

On Saturday, November 14, 2020, the defendant, his wife, and their three children were inside a residence on Vernon Drive in Dayton. After an argument, the defendant fatally shot the victim. He then gathered the children, put them in the car, drove them to a relative's home, and left. The children told the relative that their father had shot their mother.

The defendant was arrested in Montgomery, Alabama and was extradicted back to Montgomery County.

Today, the Montgomery County Grand Jury has indicted the defendant for:

- Two counts of Murder
- Two counts of Felonious Assault
- Two counts of Tampering with Evidence
- One count of Having Weapons While Under Disability – prior drug conviction

The counts of Murder and Felonious Assault also have 3-year Firearm Specifications attached.

The defendant is currently being held in the Montgomery County Jail on a \$1,000,000 bond. He will be arraigned on Thursday, January 28, 2021, at 8:30 a.m.
