Dayton Man Indicted for Germantown Pike Bar Shooting/Murder

State v. Gregory Bush, 2020-CR-2854

DAYTON, OH (09/21/2020) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **GREGORY ALAN BUSH, JR.**, 39, of Dayton, has been indicted on counts in connection to the shooting of two victims outside a Germantown Pike bar and grill, killing one.

On Friday, September 11, 2020, Sheriff's Deputies were dispatched on a report of a shooting outside Napoleans Reloaded on Germantown Pike. Upon arrival, they located a shooting victim, Lavar Edward Bagley, Sr., who was deceased. They learned that a second shooting victim had been transported to the hospital in a private vehicle.

Further investigation and evidence, including witness statements and surveillance video revealed the defendant, while inside his car, shot both victims in the parking lot.

Today, the Montgomery County Grand Jury indicted the defendant for:

- Two counts Murder
- Two counts Felonious Assault with a deadly weapon
- Two counts Felonious Assault causing serious physical harm

All of the counts have 3-year firearm specifications, for using a firearm and 5-year firearm specifications for shooting from a vehicle.

The defendant is currently in custody in the Montgomery County Jail, being held on a \$750,000 bond. He will be arraigned on Thursday, September 24, 2020, at 8:30 a.m.
