**Dayton Man Indicted for Fatal Shooting**  
*State v. Terrance Butler, 2021-CR-2014*

**DAYTON, OH (06/25/2021)** – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **TERRANCE VONJUR BUTLER**, 32, has been indicted on counts in connection to the shooting death of Mizette Printup on June 15, 2021 in Dayton.

On Tuesday, June 15, 2021, Dayton police and medics were dispatched to the 500 block of Notre Dame Avenue on a report of a shooting. A shooting victim, identified as 24-year-old Mizette Selen Printup, was transported to the hospital with serious injuries.

The investigation determined the defendant had an altercation with another male. The other male got into a vehicle with two passengers and was attempting to drive away. Two females, including the victim, were trying to catch up to the vehicle to get into it. The defendant retrieved a firearm and fired numerous rounds at the vehicle and the surrounding area, striking the vehicle and the victim before fleeing.

The victim died five days later from her injuries.

Today, the Montgomery County Grand Jury has indicted the defendant for:

- Two counts of Murder
- One count of Involuntary Manslaughter
- Six counts of Felonious Assault
- Five counts of Discharge of a Firearm On or Near a Public Roadway
- Three counts of Having Weapons While Under Disability

All of the counts except for the Having Weapons Under Disability counts include a 3-year Firearm Specification. In addition, those counts also have 54-month Firearm Specifications, because the defendant was previously convicted of a firearm specification.

The defendant will be arraigned on Tuesday, June 29, 2021, at 8:30 a.m.
