**Brothers Indicted for Double Murder**

*State v. Darryl Cleary & Derek Shaw, 2022-CR-0054*

**DAYTON, OH (01/14/2022)** – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that brothers **DARRYL FITZGERALD CLEARY**, 57, and **DEREK EDWARD SHAW**, 54, of Dayton, have been indicted on counts related to a double homicide that occurred on January 4, 2022 on Randolph Street in Dayton.

On Tuesday, January 4, 2022, Dayton police were dispatched on a report of a shooting at a residence in the 600 block of Randolph Street. When they arrived, they located a deceased male, identified as 29-year-old Darryl S. Dean, outside. Inside the residence, another deceased male, identified as 29-year-old Marty Powers, was located. A third shooting victim was also located inside the residence, who survived his injuries.

Further investigation determined the defendants had shot all three victims after an altercation inside the residence.

Today, the Montgomery County Grand Jury indicted each defendant for:

- Four counts of Murder
- Seven counts of Felonious Assault
- One count of Discharge of a Firearm On or Near Prohibited Premises
- One count of Tampering with Evidence

The counts of murder, felonious assault, and discharge of a firearm on or near prohibited premises all include 3-year firearm specifications. In addition, defendant Shaw was also indicted for one count of Having Weapons While Under Disability because of a prior drug conviction.

Both defendants are currently in custody in the Montgomery County Jail. They will be arraigned on Thursday, January 20, 2022, at 8:30 a.m.
