**Trotwood Man Indicted for Murder of Lima Woman**

*State v. Quintin Clemons, 2022-CR-393*

**DAYTON, OH (02/18/2022)** – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **QUINTIN LAMAR CLEMONS**, 38, of Trotwood, has been indicted on counts related to the shooting death of Destiny Davis on February 8, 2022 in Dayton.

In the early morning hours of Tuesday, February 8, 2022, Dayton police were dispatched on a report of a shooting on North Alder Street. Upon arrival, they located a deceased victim in front of 41 North Alder Street, later identified as 19-year-old Destiny Caprice Davis, of Lima, Ohio.

Further investigation determined the defendant had arrived at the address in a vehicle, exited the vehicle, and opened fire towards the victim, fatally striking her. The defendant then fled the area on foot.

Today, the Montgomery County Grand Jury indicted the defendant on:

- 2 counts of Murder
- 2 counts of Felonious Assault
- 1 count of Discharge of a Firearm On or Near Prohibited Premises
- 2 counts of Having Weapons While Under Disability

All of the counts, except for the counts of having weapons while under disability, include 3-year firearm specifications.

The defendant is currently in custody in the Montgomery County Jail, being held on a \$500,000 bond. The defendant will be arraigned on Thursday, February 24, 2022, at 8:30 a.m.
