Dayton Men Found Guilty in Fatal Shooting

State v. Carlos Craig 2015-CR-2107/1

DAYTON, OH (01/06/2016) – Prosecutor Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that 19-year-old **Carlos W. Craig**, of Dayton, was found guilty in the July 7, 2015 shooting death of Damarcus Bures.

Today, defendant Craig was found guilty of murder, aggravated robbery, felonious assault and illegal discharge of a firearm on or near prohibited premises. The defendant will receive a sentence of 18 years-to-life, which includes an additional mandatory 3 years for using a firearm. He is set for sentencing on February 25, 2016.

Two co-defendants, Robert Gilmore, Jr. and Jamar C. Howard, are awaiting trial.

On July 27, 2015 defendant Gilmore was indicted on counts of complicity to commit murder and complicity to commit aggravated robbery, with 3 year firearm specifications attached. Additionally, he was indicted for tampering with evidence. He is currently being held on a \$1,000,000 bond and is set for trial on February 29, 2016.

On August 31, 2015, defendant Howard was indicted on counts of complicity to commit murder and aggravated robbery, with 3 year firearm specifications attached. He is also being held on a \$1,000,000 bond and is set for trial on January 11, 2016.
