Two Dayton Men Indicted in Fatal Shooting

State v. Carlos Craig and Robert Gilmore, Jr., 2015-CR-2107

DAYTON, OH (07/27/2015) – Prosecutor Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that two men from Dayton, 19-year-old **Carlos W. Craig**, and 35-year-old **Robert Gilmore, Jr.** have been indicted for the shooting death of Damarcus Buress on July 7, 2015.

On July 7, 2015, the victim and his girlfriend were in a car on North Delmar Avenue at Washington Park. Defendant Craig and another suspect entered the vehicle. Shortly thereafter, defendant Craig fatally shot the victim with a firearm provided by defendant Gilmore.

Today, defendant Craig has been indicted on:

- Four counts Murder
- Two counts of Felonious Assault
- Two counts of Aggravated Robbery
- One count Illegal Discharge of a Firearm on Prohibited Premises

Defendant Gilmore has been indicted on:

- Two counts of Complicity to Commit Murder
- Two counts of Complicity to Commit Aggravated Robbery
- One count of Tampering With Evidence

The defendants are scheduled to be arraigned on July 30, 2015 at 8:30 a.m. Defendant Craig is in custody at the Montgomery County Jail and is being held on a \$2,000,000 bond. Defendant Gilmore is not in custody. A warrant has been issued for his arrest.

The investigation is ongoing against the third suspect.
